ORDER IN COUNCIL.

F'tle 611D. WHEREAS by "The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909," it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works, and Stormwater Drainage Works: And whereas it is further provided that the Governor may exempt reticulation works from certain sections of this Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby approves of the construction and extension by the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage of the following works under the said Act, and does hereby exempt such works from the operations of Sections 20, 21, 22, and 23 of the said Act:—

Description and Location of Reticulation Works approved and exempted. Fremantle Municipality.

Proposed 4in. diameter stoneware pipe sewer, commencing at the main sewer in Phillimore Street, and thence Northerly along Cliff Street, a distance of 220 feet, as shown on House Drainage Plan No. 1913.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 5th day of October, 1921.

Food and Drug Regulations, 1913-18.

Regulations for Inspecting Imported.

M.P.H. 390/20; No. 4069.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 202 of "The Health Act, 1911-19," His Excellency the Governor may make Regulations, and may repeal, alter, or amend any Regulations so made: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the advice of the Advisory Committee, doth hereby make the following Regulations:—

Frozen Fish.

1. Every consignment of frozen, cured, or otherwise preserved fish not being in hermetically sealed packages shall be subject to inspection and examination on arrival from without the Commonwealth of Australia.

2. No person shall remove from the wharf at the port of arrival any portion of such consignment, unless and until such consignment has been examined and passed as wholesome and fit for human consumption; provided that the examining inspector may permit all

or any portion of such consignment to be removed into cold storage, from which place it shall not be removed without his consent until after examination and approval.

3. The fee to be paid for the inspection or examination shall be in accordance with the Schedule hereto, and such fee shall be payable by the consignee or other person having the custody of such consignment on demand by the Commissioner or an Inspector.

4. Whenever on examination any consignment or portion thereof is found to be unfit for human consumption, such consignment shall be destroyed or otherwise dealt with as the Commissioner may direct, and a certificate of condemnation under the hand of the Inspector shall be given when required.

Schedule.

For every 14lbs, of frozen, smoked, salted, cured, or otherwise preserved Fish or portions of Fish—1d.

Forwarding of Samples of Food or Drugs for analysis.

M.P.H. 7110/21; Ex. Co. No. 4012. WHEREAS Section 191, Subsection 7, of the Health Act provides a certain procedure whereby a sample of food or drug is to be sent to an analyst, and whereas the said section provides that any other method as may be prescribed may be utilised for such purpose; and whereas it is desired to prescribe some other manner by which any sample as aforesaid may be forwarded to an analyst: Now, therefore, the following manner is prescribed as being one whereby a sample of food or drug may be forwarded to an analyst:—

1. By carriage as a packet parcel by rail.

2. By delivery to the analyst by a messenger. In either case the sample of food or drug shall be securely packed and shall be sealed by the person requiring the analysis to be made. The analyst receiving such sample shall furnish to the person requiring the analysis a certificate as to whether the package was received by him with the seal intact or otherwise.
