The Prices Regulation Act, 1919-20.

Determination of Prices.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Prices Regulation Act, 1919," as amended by "The Prices Regulation Act Amendment and Continuance Act, 1920," the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Commissioners, by Order in Council determine the maximum prices, whether retail or wholesale, which may be charged for foodstuffs and necessary commodities in any proclaimed area; and without affecting the generality of the powers conferred may determine such prices on the basis of producing, manufacturing, landed delivery; or other cost, and may declare what items may or may not be included in such cost: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and on the recommendation of the Commissioners, doth hereby determine that the prices of the necessary commodity mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall be the maximum retail prices that may be charged for such necessary commodity within the Bunbury, Kalgoorlie, and Metropolitan Areas, and, subject as therein provided, in all other proclaimed areas.

Metropolitan Area.—22s. 6d. per case; 11s. 6d. per tin. In bottles (six to the gallon), 7d. per bottle.

The bottle price within the Metropolitan Area does not include the price of the container, which may be charged for, but the amount must be refunded if the container is returned in good condition.

Bunbury Area.—24s. per case; 12s. 3d. per tin.

Kalgoorlie Area.—28s. per case; 14s. 3d. per tin.

The above-mentioned retail prices have been fixed with due regard to the cost of transport within the Bunbury, Kalgoorlie, and Metropolitan Areas; within other proclaimed areas the equivalent of any additional cost actually incurred in transportation beyond the Bunbury, Kalgoorlie, and Metropolitan Areas may be added to the above-mentioned prices.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council has approved of Regulation 33 of the Education Department being amended, as set out hereunder:—

Regulation 33.—A teacher, whatever his grade, on appointment to any school, must notify the Minister of the date of his arrival and of his commencing duty. Teachers on the permanent staff must give three months' notice of intended resignation. No such notice may terminate between the 1st January and the 31st March. Teachers not on the permanent staff must give at least one month's notice; no such notice shall terminate between the 1st January and the last day of February. When full notice is not given, pay may be forfeited at the discretion of the Minister. Before receiving the salary for the last month, he must, if in charge of a school, hand over to a person duly authorised all school property belonging to the Minister, and make out, in duplicate, an inventory of the same; one copy to be forwarded to the Minister, the other to be left in the school portfolio, both copies to be certified by the person authorised to receive the school property. He must also have sent in attendance returns made up to the date of his leaving, and he must be able to show all books and records complete and in order. The Minister, on a report from the Director of Education, may require the retirement of any teacher who has reached the age of sixty years. A teacher automatically vacates his position on reaching the age of 65, unless the Governor in Council has previously directed him to continue in the service.
