AT a Meeting of the Executive Council, held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 31st day of May, 1922, the following Order in Council was authorised to be issued:—

The Public Works Act, 1902. Land Drainage—Benger Swamp. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by Section 11 of "The Public Works Act, 1902," it is made lawful for the Governor, by Order in Council, to authorise the Minister to undertake, construct, or provide any Public Work (subject as to Railways to Section 96), and such authorisation shall be deemed an authority to such Minister by and under that Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Excentive Council and in exercise of the power conferred by the recited section of "The Public Works Act, 1902," doth hereby authorise the Honourable Minister for Works and Trading Concerns to provide a drain through Wellington Location 1, as shown coloured green on Plan P.W.D., W.A., 21967 (L.T.O. 4643), which may be inspected at the office of the Minister for Works and Trading Concerns, Perth.

The Land Act, 1898. ORDER IN COUNCIL,

15750/08.

WHEREAS by Section 43 of "The Land Act, 1898," it is made lawful for the Governor, by Order in Council, without issuing any deed of grant, to place any Reserve under the control of any Municipality, Road Board, or other person or persons, as a Board of Management, and to empower such Board to make, repeal, and alter Bylaws for the control and management of such Reserves, such By-laws to be approved by the Governor and published in the Government Gazette: And whereas it is deemed expedient that the Reserves set out in the Schedule attached hereto should be placed under the control of the General Manager of the State Hotels, as a Board of Management: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor and Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Excentive Council, doth hereby revoke the appointment of any other person or persons heretofore appointed a Board of Management or charged with the control or management of such Reserves or any of them, and doth hereby place such Reserves under the control of Joseph Robert Campbell, General Manager of State Hotels, as a Board of Management, and doth empower the said Joseph Robert Campbell as such Board to make, repeal, or alter by-laws for the control and management of the said Reserves, and to impose penalties not exceeding £5 for any breach thereof and £2 a day for a continuing breach, but not more than £20 in the aggregate.
