ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by Section 42 of "The Land Act, 1898," it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any Reserve shall vest in and be held by any Municipality, Road Board, or other person or persons to be named in the order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in Section 39 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order: And whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 18067 whereas it is deemed expedient that neserve no. 18007 (near Lake Grace) should vest in and be held by the Hon. the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage, in trust for the purpose of Water Supply: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Administrator, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Coun-

cil, doth hereby direct that the before-mentioned Reserve shall vest in and be held by the Hon, the Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage, in trust for the purpose aforesaid; subject, nevertheless, to the powers reserved to him by Section 41 of the said Act.

Wages.

The following shall be the scale of wages to in-

(a) Inmates in the Intermediate Class, not being artisans or clerks, shall receive the same scale of wages as prisoners who are not inmates of a Reformatory Prison, and, when classed as artisans or clerks, such immates shall receive double that scale.

Inmates in the Intermediate Class may spend one-half of the amount earned by them on the purchase of

luxuries; the balance shall be placed to their credit.
(b) For male inmates in the High and Highest Classes:

4s. per week. Artisans and clerks .. 6s. per week.

Two shillings per week of the above amounts may be spent on the purchase of luxuries, and the balance shall be placed to the credit of the inmate.

(c) Female inmates in the High and Highest Classes shall receive and may spend half the above amounts prescribed for male prisoners in the same classes, and the balances shall be placed to the credit of the inmates.
