WHEREAS by Clause 14 of the Letters Patent passed under the Great Seal of the United Kingdom constituting the office of Governor of the State of Western Australia and its Dependencies bearing date the 29th Australia and its Dependencies bearing date the 29th October, 1900, it is provided that in the event of the Governor having occasion to be temporarily absent for a short period from the seat of Government or from the State, he may in every such case, by an Instrument under the Public Seal of the State, constitute and appoint the Lieutenant-Governor, or if there be no such officer then any other person, to be his Deputy during such temporary absence, and in that capacity to exercise, perform and execute, for and on behalf of the cise, perform and execute, for and on behalf of the Governor, during such absence but no longer, all such Governor, during such absence but no longer, all such powers and authorities vested in the Governor by the said Letters Patent, as shall in and by such Instrument be specified and limited, but no others: And whereas I, the said Governor, having occasion to be temporarily absent for a short period, not exceeding one month, from the seat of Government, and in consequence am desirors to appoint a Deputy to exercise, perform and execute for and on my behalf the powers and authorities hereinafter specified and no others: Now therefore I, the said Governor, by virtue and in exercise of the powers said Governor, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid, do by this Instrument under the Public Seal of the State constitute and appoint you,

the said Sir Robert Furse McMillan, my Deputy during such absence to exercise, perform and execute, for and on my behalf as such Governor, all the powers and authorities vested in the Governor by the said recited Letters Patent.

This Commission shall take effect as from the 5th day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twentythree.
