AT a Meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chambers, this nineteenth day of September, 1923, the following Order in Council was authorised to be issued:—

## ORDER IN COUNCIL.

*Land Drainage Act, 1900.*

P.W.W.S. 229/23.

WHEREAS by Section 4 of "The Land Drainage Act, 1900," the Governor is empowered, by Order in Council, on petition in that behalf from a majority of the rate-payers in any part of the State, to declare any lands to be a Drainage District for the purposes of the said Act, and to define the boundaries and give a name to such District; and whereas such a petition was presented for

the constitution of such a District at Nenamup; and whereas in constituting such District the boundaries were misdescribed thereby, including a portion of the Saide Drainage District, namely, the area described in the schedule hereto: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, does hereby amend the description of the boundaries of the said District at Nenamup, by excluding the area described in the Schedule hereto.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the date hereof.

12. Chemistry.
13. Biology.
14. Geology.
15. Agricultural Science.

If Mathematics and Physics be not selected under (3), the Candidate must have obtained a pass in these subjects at the Junior Standard.

Of the four subjects necessary at the Leaving Standard, at least three shall be passed at one and the same examination, and the remaining subject at any subsequent examination.
