*The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909.*

## ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M. W. S. 1227/23.

WHEREAS by "The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909," it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct and extend Water Works, Sewerage Works, and Stormwater Drainage Works, and whereas it is further provided that the Governor may exempt reticulation works from certain sections of this Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby approves of the construction and extension by the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage of the following works under the said Act, and does hereby exempt such works from the operations of Sections 20, 21, 22, and 23 of the said Act:—

*Description and Location of Reticulation Works approved and exempted.*

*City of Perth.*

*Inglewood Ward.*

*Water Supply Improvements.*

Proposed 6-inch diameter cast-iron water main, commencing from existing 6-inch main at the intersection of North Street and Second Avenue; thence north-easterly along North Street to Fourth Avenue, a distance of 14½ chains; thence south-easterly along Fourth Avenue a 4-inch diameter cast-iron water main to connect with existing 4-inch water main at lot 135; length about 17 chains. A 3-inch diameter cast-iron water main, commencing from proposed 6-inch diameter main at Second Avenue; thence south-easterly to Lot 314, connecting with existing 3-inch main (length about 10½ chains), together with valves, hydrants, and all necessary connections and apparatus, as indicated in red on Plan M.W.S., S., & D.D., W.A., No. 4246.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the fourteenth day of December, 1923.

## ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS the Governor in Council, under the powers of "The Explosives Act, 1895," may from time to time by order, define the composition, quality, and character of an explosive, and may classify explosives, and may prohibit the manufacture, keeping, importation, and sale of any explosive, when considered expedient for the public safety: And whereas on the 20th day of July, 1904, the Governor in Council made an Order classifying certain explosives and prohibiting any other explosives: Now, therefore, the Governor in Council does hereby order that the following explosive be added to those thereby authorised for manufacture, keeping, importation, and sale, and that it be classified as follows:—

Class 6.—Ammunition, Division 3.

"Detonators (Tetryl)."

## ORDER IN COUNCIL.

2856/23.

WHEREAS by Section 42 of "The Pearling Act, 1912-19," it is made lawful for the Governor to close any portion of a pearl-shell area, and to prohibit the gathering, collection, or removal of any pearls or pearl-shell within or from the portion so closed, for a specific period: And whereas it is deemed expedient that the whole of that portion of the Shark Bay Pearl-shell Area known as South Passage Section, other than those portions held under Exclusive License, shall be closed, and that the gathering, collection, or removal of pearls or pearl-shells within or from that portion so closed shall be prohibited: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby directs that the above-mentioned portion of the said Pearl-shell Area shall be closed, and that the gathering, collection, or removal of pearls or pearl-shells within or from the portion so closed shall be prohibited for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of publication of this notice in the *Government Gazette*.
