2054/18. Robert Campion, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished order of Governor in and over the State of Western Australin and its Dependencies in the Commonwenth of Australla.

WHEREAS by Sections 222 and 227 of" "Tho Municipal Corporations Act, 1906' (6 Edwardi, No. 32), it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request of the Council, by notice in the Goyernment Gactte, to declare any land reserved, used, or by purchase or exchange actuired for a street or way, or any place, bridge, or thoroughfare, to be a publie highway, and such had shall therenpon and thenceforth, from the date of sheh Proclamation, become and be absolutely dedicated to the public as a publie highway within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force: And whereas the Northam Municipal Council has requested that fertain land named and described in the Schedule heremder which has been used for street or way within the Muncipality of Northam, bo declared a publie highway: Now therefore I, the said Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Conncil, do by this my Proclamation declare the sadid land to be a public highway, and such land shall, from the date of this Proctamation, be absolutely dedicated to the public as a highway within the meaning of any law now or hereafier in foree.

WHEREAS by "The Mctropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909,' it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct and extend Waterworks, Sewerage Works, and Stormwater Drainage Works; and whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied with, and plans, sections, and estimates in respect of the works hereinafter mentioned have been submitted to and approved by the Governor in Comeil: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby empower the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act, namely:-

30 in . diameter Steel Pipe Line from Wungong Brook Dam Site to Kelmseott and Pipe Head Dan; 30in. diameter Steel Pipe Line from Canning No. 2 Dam Site to junction with Churchman's Brook Pipe Line, and Pipe Head Dam; as indicated on Plan M.W.S., S., \& D.D., W.A., No. 4253.

## The Land Act, 1898.

## ORDER IN COUNOL.

Corr. No. 843/09.
WHEREAS by Section 43 of "The Land Act, 1898,"' it is made lawful for the Governor, by Order in Council, without issuing any deed of grant, to place any Reserve under the control of any Municipality, Road Board, or other person or persons, as a Board of Management, and to empower such Board to make, repeal, and alter bylaws for the control and management of such Reserves, and prescribe fees for depasturing thereon, and for other purposes, such by-laws to be approved by the Governor and published in the Government Gazette: And whereas it is deemed expedient that that portion of Mullewa Townsite Reserve at present mabubdivided and not reserved for any specific puposes should be placed under the control of the Mnllewa Road Board as a Board of Management: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby place the before-mentioned area under the control of the Mullewa Road Board, for the purpose of a Temporary Common as a Board of Managoment, and doth empower such Board to make, repeal, or alter bylaws for the control and management of the said area; for prescribing fees for depasturing thereon; for direct-
ing the manner in which such fees shall be imposen, pait, collected, and disposed of, and to impose penalies not oxceeding in any case e5 for any breach thereof, and 52 a day for a contiming breach, but not more than $£ 20$ in the aggregate.
The Order in Council published in the Government Gazette of 27 th August, 1909 , re the above is hereby superseded.
