The British Imperial Oil Company Limited's Act, 1925.

Power to The British Lmperial Oil Company, Limited, to erect reservoirs for the storage of oil, liquid fuel, petroleum spirits, kerosene, and petroleum protuets and supply of same; compulsory user of roads, etc.; power to lay down pipes, etc., in streets, under railways, and in Government lands and along wharves, and exercise other powers.
