PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA,

By His Excellency Sir Robert Furse
McMillan, K.C.M.G., Lieutenant-Governor in
and over the State of Western Australia
and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by Section 158 of "The Factories and Shops Act, 1920," it is enacted that the Governor may by Proclamation temporarily suspend the operations of the said Act in so far as it applies to the closing times fixed or appointed for any shop or shops; and whereas it is expedient to exercise such power in manner hereinafter appearing: Now therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby by this Proclamation suspend the operations of the said Act between the hours of 6 p.m. and 9 p.m. on Thursday, the 1st April, 1926, in so far as it applies to the closing time of all shops situated in the Collie Shop District.

WHEREAS it is enacted by "The Factories and Shops Act, 1920," that the expression "Public Holiday" shall mean certain days therein specified and any other day declared by Proclamation to be a public holiday for the purposes of the said Act: Now therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, acting under the powers contained in the said Act and every other power me in this behalf enabling, do hereby proclaim and declare that Saturday, the 3rd day of April, 1926, shall be a public holiday in the Collie Shop District, for the purpose of the said Act, and shall be observed as a public holiday under every part of the said Act in which the expression occurs.
