ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 3073/24.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," the Governor may by Order in Council sever any portion of a Road District and annex it to an existing Road District: And whereas it is desirable to sever portion of the Upper Gascoyne Road District and annex it to the Meekatharra Road District: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor's Deputy, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive

Council, under the provisions of the said Act and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby:—

- (1) Sever that portion of the Upper Gascoyne Road District as described in the Schedule hereto and annex it to the Meekatharra Road District.

*The Traffic Act, 1919.**Upper Blackwood Road Board.*

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 4835/21.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Traffic Act, 1919," the Governor may by Order in Council empower a Local Authority to exercise within its district any power of making regulations which the Governor can exercise under Division 4 of Part IV. of the said Act: And whereas it is advisable to empower the Upper Blackwood Road Board to prohibit the passing of heavy traffic over those portions of the roads, described in the schedule hereto, within its districts during the months of June, July, August, and September, 1926, and that heavy traffic for such purpose shall be as set out in Nos. 149 and 150 of the Traffic Regulations, as published in the *Government Gazette* dated 5th of September, 1924: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor's Deputy, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, under the provisions of the said Act and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby empower the Upper Blackwood Road Board to prohibit the passage of heavy traffic over those portions of the roads, described in the schedule hereto, within its district, and to direct that during the months of June, July, August, and September for year 1926 heavy traffic is prohibited over those portions of the roads, described in the schedule hereto, within the Upper Blackwood Road District accordingly, and also that any person acting in contravention of this Order shall be liable to a penalty of not exceeding twenty pounds, as set forth in No. 150 of the Traffic Regulations gazetted on the fifth of September, 1924.
