PUBLIC SERVICE RECLASSIFICATION

DATING FROM

1st JULY, 1926.

PREFACE

TO

THE RECLASSIFICATION OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE (1926).

BASIS OF CLASSIFICATION.

This classification is made under the provisions of Section 12 of the Public Service Appeal Board Act, 1920, which reads as follows:—

“Notwithstanding any provision of the Public Service Act, 1904, to the contrary, the classification of offices and officers under the Public Service Act, 1904, and the fixing of the salaries of officers, inclusive of officers in the Administrative Division, shall be vested, and as from the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty, shall be deemed to have been vested, in the Public Service Commissioner, acting alone or in conjunction with Assistant Commissioners, subject to an appeal to the Board under this Act.”

On the two previous occasions when a reclassification has been made, two Assistant Commissioners were appointed to assist me.

In my opinion better results could be achieved in this classification by consulting the responsible officer of each Department.

For this purpose forms were issued to each Department—

- (a) To supply a list of the officers working under their direction, showing their present duties ;
- (b) To state if these duties were similar in nature to those of the office when last classified (1920) ;
- (c) If not, in what respect the duties had increased or decreased in value ;
- (d) Any remarks they desired to make.

Each officer initialled the list of his duties to show that he concurred with the description outlined by the Officer in charge of the Branch. The Head of Sub-department was then invited to state if he agreed with the information given, and also, if the value of the office had increased or decreased, what increased or decreased maximum he would recommend ; or, if the position was a new one, what in his opinion was its maximum value.

The whole of this information was then passed on to the Permanent Head for his opinion and to forward to the Commissioner.

It will be seen, therefore, that the completed forms contained the considered opinions of the officers responsible for the administration of the Branch, Sub-department, and Department.

I also invited the Civil Service Association and the Committees associated therewith, such as the “Draftsmen’s” and “Accountants’,” to collect and submit information which in their opinion would be of assistance to me. The Association responded very fully to this invitation, for which I desire to express my appreciation.

In addition to the information supplied on the forms I consulted the responsible officers, both Professional and Clerical, but referred particularly to the Engineer-in-Chief in regard to all matters pertaining to Engineering and

Engineering Drafting ; and to the Surveyor General in regard to all survey matters, irrespective of the Department affected.

I have also sought in this classification to adjust anomalies.

The forms were sent to the Departments on the 17th March, 1926, and were returned by the Permanent Heads on the 18th May.

SCALES OF SALARIES.

Clerical.—The following schedule shows the amendments made in what is known as the Automatic Range as applied to the Clerical Division :—

In many cases where female officers are performing clerical duties or doing shorthand work which requires special ability, salaries in excess of the amounts shown above have been provided.

The above schedule is based on age, and therefore does not apply to those who have not graduated through the Service from the Junior ranks.

The varied class of work in the Clerical Division does not lend itself to reduction to schedule form ; the only instance in which this has been possible above the Automatic Range is in the case of Branch Managers of the Savings Bank. The valuation of these positions has been made on the following basis :—

PROFESSIONAL.

Engineers.—Provision has been made for three sections of Engineers, carrying salaries at the following rates :—

£504—£528—£552—£576—£600
£408—£432—£456—£480—£504
£324—£336—£348—£360—£384—£408

The Engineering Division is recruited as far as possible from Cadets trained in the Department on a five years' cadetship.

When a Cadet has satisfactorily completed his cadetship, he is appointed as a Probationary Engineer for a term of one year at a salary of £252 per annum. If at the end of this period the Engineer-in-Chief certifies that his services are satisfactory he is then appointed an Assistant Engineer.

Promotion of Engineers.—Under this classification an Assistant Engineer whose range is from £324—£408 will, on attaining his maximum, automatically pass on to a classification of £408—£504, subject to a certificate from the Engineer-in-Chief—

- (a) That his general efficiency is satisfactory ;
- (b) That the volume, character, and importance of the works in hand necessitate his employment at the higher range ;

but he will not be advanced beyond £504 per annum until he possesses one or more of the following qualifications according to the nature of the work on which he is employed :—

A.M.I.C.E. ; A.M.I.E.A. ; A.M.I.Mech.E. ; B.E., etc.

Draftsmen.—The Drafting Staff of the Public Works Department has been divided into classes as follows :—

Draftswomen.—A new departure has been made in the provision for Draftswomen, who will be engaged on the more simple form of drafting with a maximum classification of £228. Female officers engaged on tracing will be retained on the Temporary Staff.

INCREASES IN SALARY AND RANGE.

As shown in the first schedule, Junior officers beginning at £72 per annum at the age of 16 will receive an annual increment of £24 up to 20 years of age, and an increase of £36 on reaching 21 years of age. Adult Clerks will be paid on the basis of an increase of £24 on present rates, viz. : £204 at 21, to £288 at 26, in lieu of £180—£264. This increase has not been applied automatically throughout the classification, although there are comparatively few instances where this amount at least has not been added to the salary, whilst the maximum has in many instances been raised by a much greater amount.

Except in the automatic stage the amount placed in the column "Salary from 1st July, 1926," is payable only where the increase is due from such date. In cases where an increase has been paid since 1st July, 1925, the salary stated will date from 12 months after the previous increase in accordance with Public Service Regulation 128.

Under this classification advancement of officers until they attain their maximum shall be by yearly increments, subject to satisfactory report regarding conduct, diligence and general efficiency, as required by Public Service Regulation 46.

POSITIONS NOT CLASSIFIED.

It will be noticed that in some instances positions have not been classified. These relate to—

- (a) Officers engaged in Trading Concerns ;
- (b) Officers who will be affected by proposed reorganisation ; and
- (c) Officers whom it is proposed shortly to retire.

Regarding (a)—I would point out that at the date the Public Service Act came into operation, Trading Concerns were not contemplated, and consequently the Act and Regulations cannot be conveniently applied to these.

It has to be remembered that most of the Trading Concerns have to compete for their business, and it is necessary therefore that they should as far as possible have equal freedom with their competitors in handling their staff.

The Permanent officers (above the Automatic) engaged in Trading Concerns have been shown with fixed salaries but no classification, and their remuneration, if necessary, can be increased or decreased as the fluctuations of business or other causes may require.

QUALIFIED ACCOUNTANTS.

A matter brought forward by the Accountants' Committee of the Association was the granting of some special allowance to officers who sought to increase their efficiency by qualifying in Accountancy, and a special cash allowance of £12 will be granted to officers employed in Accounts Offices whose classification comes within the Automatic range and who have passed or may pass the Final Examination of a recognised Institute of Accountants.

HIS Excellency the Governor in Executive Council has approved of the following amendments to the Public Service Regulations, to date from 1st July, 1926:—

Regulation 75: Amended by the deletion of the words "£264 and under" and "over £264" in the headings of the Schedule and the substitution of the words "£288 and under" and "over £288."

Regulation 98: Amended to read as follows:—

"Except as hereinafter provided, every candidate admitted to the Service after passing the prescribed examination, or such other examination as the Commissioner, in writing, shall accept as equivalent thereto, shall be appointed at a commencing salary of £72 per annum, if at the age of 16, and if over that age, according to the following scale, rising by annual increments on the age basis to a maximum of £168 per annum:

Age 17	..	£96 per annum.
" 18	..	£120 "
" 19	..	£144 "
" 20	..	£168 "

"Officers appointed to the Clerical Division will, after attaining the age of 19 years, be required to pass a promotional examination before being promoted to a senior position, and, subject to passing such promotional examination, will, on attaining the age of 21,

be paid a salary of £204 per annum, rising by annual increments, as prescribed in the scale hereunder, to a maximum of £288 per annum.

"The scale of salaries above £180 shall be as follows:—

"All increments given under this and the succeeding regulations are subject to Regulation 46.

This Regulation shall apply to all male officers in the Clerical and Professional Divisions (other than Cadets) and to such officers in the General Division as the Commissioner may from time to time approve."

Regulation 99: Amended by the deletion of the first three lines and to the word "Service" in the 4th line, and the substitution of the following: "The scale of salaries payable to Female Officers under 21 years of age shall be as follows:—
