To Our Trusty and Well-beloved George Tuthill Wood, Esquire, Magistrate of the Local Court, Perth.

GREETING:

KNOW you that I, the said Governor, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby appoint you to be a Commissioner to investigate-

- (1) The circumstances of the arrest in June, 1926, of the aboriginal "Lumbia" on a charge of the wilful murder of Frederick William Hay.
- (2) The facts relating to the alleged killing and burning of the bodies of aborigines in or about June, 1926, at Gotegote Merrie and Mowerie, in the Forrest River District, by native trackers and police boys, when such aborigines were about to be arrested by, or while in the custody of, Police Constables Regan and St. Jack, assisted by special Constables O'Leary and Jolly.
- The circumstances of the alleged killing of four aborigines and the burning of their bodies at or near a place called "Dala" while in the custody of Police Constables Regan and St. Jack.
- (4.) The disappearance of the aboriginal "Tommy," lately in the employment of Leopold Overheu, and who, it is alleged, can give material evidence in this inquiry.
- The employment by the police of armed aboriginal trackers and police boys in executing warrants for the arrest of aborigines, such trackers and police boys not being, it is alleged, under the efficient and proper control of responsible officers.

And I declare this to be a Royal Commission within the meaning of "The Royal Commissioners" Powers Act, 1902": And do hereby desire and request you, with as little delay as possible, to report to me in writing the result of your inquiries by virtue of this CommisGiven under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this 26th day of January, 1927.
