AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 3rd day of February, 1927, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

The Traffic Act, 1919-26.

Bridgetown Road Board.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 1066/24.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Traffic Act, 1919-26," the Governor may by Order in Council empower a Local Authority to exercise within its district any power of making regulations which the Governor can exercise under Division 4, Part IV., of the said Act; and whereas it is advisable to empower the Bridgetown Road Board to prohibit vehicles standing on those portions of Hampton and Steere Streets, as described in Schedule hereto: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, under the provisions of the said Act and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby empower the Bridgetown Road Board, by the By-law in Schedule hereto, to prohibit vehicles standing in those portions of Hampton and Steere Streets, as described in Schedule hereto, and to impose a penalty not exceeding £20 for the breach thereof.

THE TRAFFIC ACT, 1919-26.

Bridgetown Road Board.

Under Section 43 of "The Traffic Act, 1919-26," the following By-law was passed by the Bridgetown Road Board on the 14th January, 1927:—

The standing of vehicles within 33 feet of the street corners at the intersection of Hampton and Steere Streets is hereby prohibited.

Any person who commits a breach of the By-law shall be liable, on conviction, to a penalty not exceeding £20.

The Land Act, 1898.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corr. No. 6587/26.

WHEREAS by Section 42 of "The Land Act, 1898," it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any reserve shall vest in and be held by any Municipality, Road Board, or other person or persons to be named in the order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in Section 39 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order: And whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 19431, Meekatharra Lots 118 and 119 should vest in and be held by the Meekatharra Road Board in trust for the purpose of Recreation: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the before-mentioned reserve shall vest in and be held by the Meekatharra Road Board in trust for the purpose aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by Section 41 of the said Act.

The Land Act, 1898.
ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corr. No. 4450/11.

WHEREAS by Section 43 of "The Land Act, 1898," it is made lawful for the Governor, by Order in Council, without issuing any deed of grant, to place any reserve under the control of any Municipality, Road Board, or other person or persons, as a Board of Management, and to empower such Board to make, repeal, and alter by-laws for the control and management of such reserves, and prescribe fees for depasturing thereon, and for other purposes, such by-laws to be approved by the Governor and published in the *Government Gazette*: And whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve 13892, for Recreation and Camping, at Lake Mortigalup, should be placed under the control of the Plantagenet Road Board as a Board of Management: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby place the before-mentioned reserve under the control of the Plantagenet Road Board as a Board of Management, and doth empower such Board to make, repeal, or alter by-laws for the control and management of the said reserve; for prescribing fees for depasturing thereon; for directing the manner in which such fees shall be imposed, paid, collected, and disposed of, and to impose penalties not exceeding in any case £5 for any breach thereof, and £2 a day for a continuing breach, but not more than £20 in the aggregate.
