THE ELECTORAL ACT, 1907 (AS AMENDED).

*Legislative Assembly General Elections, 1927.*

IT is hereby notified, for general information, that I have this day received from His Excellency the Governor a Warrant, under the provisions of Section 63 of the abovementioned Act, authorising and directing me to proceed forthwith to issue Writs for the election of one Member for each District within the State of Western Australia.

Pursuant to such Warrant, I have this day issued the Writs accordingly, and the following dates have

been appointed for the purposes of such election, viz.:—

1. For nomination, Tuesday, the 1st day of March, 1927, at 12 o'clock noon.
2. For taking the poll, in case of the election being contested, Saturday, the 26th day of March, 1927.
3. For return of Writ, Friday, the 22nd day of April, 1927.
