PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is enacted by "The Factories and Shops Act, 1920," that the expression "Public Holiday" shall mean certain days therein specified and any other day declared by Proclamation to be a public holiday for the purposes of the said Act: Now therefore I, the said Lieut.-Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, acting under the powers contained in the said Act, and every other power me in this behalf enabling, do hereby proclaim and declare that Monday, the 2nd day of May, 1927, shall be observed as a public holiday under every part of the said Act in which the expression occurs.

Establishment of a Local Court at Wyalkatchem.

WHEREAS by Section 5 of "The Local Courts Act, 1904-1921," the Governor may by Proclamation order that Courts, to be called Local Courts, shall be held at such places as he thinks fit: And whereas it is deemed expedient to establish a sitting of a Local Court at Wyalkatchem once in every two months: Now, therefore I, the said Lieut.-Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order that a Local Court,

under the said Act, shall be holden at Wyalkatchem once in every two months, commencing in May, 1927.

AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chambers, at Perth, this 27th day of April, 1927, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 1023/22.

WHEREAS by "The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909," it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct and extend water works, sewerage works, and stormwater drainage works: And whereas it is further provided that the Governor may exempt reticulation works from certain sections of this Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby approves of the construction and extension by the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage of the following works under the said Act, and does hereby exempt such works from the operations of Sections 20, 21, 22, and 23 of the said Act.

Description and Location of Reticulation Works approved and exempted—Metropolitan Reticulation Main Improvements—Claremont Municipality:—(a) Proposed 3-inch water main commencing at the intersection of Perth-Fremantle Road and Mary Street and proceeding in a Northerly direction along Mary Street to Guger Street (length about 10½ chains).

(b) Proposed 3-inch water main commencing at the intersection of Perth-Fremantle Road and Langsford

Street and proceeding in a Northerly direction along Langsford Street to Stephen Street (length about 12 chains).

(c) Proposed 3-inch water main commencing at the intersection of Perth-Fremantle Road and Vacluse Street and proceeding in a Northerly direction along Vacluse Street to Stephen Street (length about 11½ chains), together with valves, hydrants, and all necessary apparatus, and including lifting existing 1½-inch tubing, as indicated in red on M.W.S., S., & D.D., W.A., Plan No. 4664.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 29th day of April, 1927.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 318/27.

WHEREAS by "The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909," it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct and extend water works, sewerage works, and stormwater drainage works: And whereas it is further provided that the Governor may exempt reticulation works from certain sections of this Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby approves of the construction and extension by the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage of the following works under the said Act, and does hereby exempt such works from the operations of Sections 20, 21, 22, and 23 of the said Act.

Description and Location of Reticulation Works approved and exempted—Metropolitan Reticulation Main Improvements—Bassendean Road District:—Proposed 4-inch water main commencing from the existing main at the intersection of West Road and Guildford Road and proceeding in a Southerly direction along the East side of West Road to Watson Street (length about 37½ chains). Proposed 2-inch water main commencing from the intersection of Watson Street and West Road and proceeding in a Southerly direction along the East side of West Road to Housome Street (length 28 chains), together with valves, hydrants, and all necessary apparatus, including lifting of existing 1-inch and 2-inch tubing, as indicated in red on M.W.S., S., & D.D., W.A., Plan No. 4657.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 29th day of April, 1927.
