M.R.B. 782/27.

WHEREAS by Section 13 of "The Main Roads Act,
1925," the Governor may on the recommendation of the
Board declare by Proclamation that any road shall be
a main road: And whereas the Main Roads Board has
recommended that the road specified in the Schedule

hereto be so declared: Now, therefore, His Excellency
the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the
Executive Council, hereby declares that the road speci-
fied in the Schedule hereto shall be a main road within
the meaning of "The Main Roads Act, 1925," and that
the footpaths, if any, of such road be excluded from
the main road.

The Schedule.

*Northam-York-Cranbrook Road. (York, Beverley, Brook-
ton Pingelly, Cuballing, and Narrogin Road Board
Districts, and York Municipality.)*

A strip of land, one chain wide, commencing at the
Northern boundary of York Road Board District, pro-
ceeding along Road No. 107; thence South-Easterly
through York Road Board District, along Road No. 31
to its junction with Road No. 349; thence along Road
No. 31 in a South-Westerly direction to the Eastern
boundary of the Municipality of York; thence proceed-
ing in a Westerly and South-Westerly direction along
Northam Road to the junction of Lincoln Street and
Steere Road; thence Westerly along Lincoln Street to
Newcastle Street; thence Southerly along Newcastle
Street to Ford Street; thence Westerly along Ford
Street crossing the Avon River and continuing along
Ford Street to Avon Terrace; thence Southerly along
Avon Terrace to Henrietta Street; thence South-East-
erly along Beverley Road to the Municipal boundary of
the Municipality of York; continuing in a South-East-
erly direction along Beverley Road crossing the York-
Greenhills Railway Line and continuing generally in a
South-Easterly and Southerly direction, following the
Great Southern Railway Line, on the East side to the
Northern boundary of and through the Beverley Road
Board District, crossing the Great Southern Railway
Line at the Southern boundary of Lot No. 53; thence
along the South-Western side of the said railway line
through Beverley townsite, again crossing the said rail-
way line at the Southern end of Hunt Road, opposite
Reserve No. 2026 and continuing generally Southerly
to the Southern boundary of Beverley Road Board Dis-
trict, at the South-Western corner of Location No.
4937; thence through Brookton Road Board District,
following a Southerly direction to the North-West bound-
ary of Location No. 5336; thence Westerly again cross-

ing the Great Southern Railway Line in the townsite of Brookton; thence South-Easterly along the West side of the said Railway Line, through Kulyaling Townsite to the Northern boundary of Pingelly Road Board District, at the North-Eastern corner of Lot No. 16; thence South-Easterly, along Road No. 750, on the South-West side of the Great Southern Railway Line, through Pingelly Road Board District and the Townsite of Pingelly to the Southern boundary of the Pingelly Road Board District, at the South-East corner of Location No. 5594; thence following a general South-Easterly and Southerly direction, through Cuballing Road Board District along the West side of the Great Southern Railway Line to Popanyinning Townsite, again crossing the said railway line and continuing along the Eastern side of the said railway line to the Townsite of Yornaning; thence South-Easterly, following the said Railway Line on its Eastern side to Cuballing Townsite, crossing the said Railway Line to the Western side and recrossing the said Railway Line to its Eastern side in the Townsite of Cuballing; thence in a Southerly direction, following the Great Southern Railway Line, and on to the Southern boundary of Cuballing Road Board District, at the South-West corner of Lot No. 13; thence Southerly through Narrogin Road Board District, to the Northern boundary of the Townsite of Narrogin at the South-East corner of Location No. 339, as indicated by brown line on Plan M.R.B., W.A., No. 164.

State Savings Bank, Subiaco.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 763/27; Ex. Co. No. 2393.

WHEREAS by Section 11 of "The Public Works Act, 1902," it is made lawful for the Governor by Order in Council to authorise the Minister to undertake, construct, or provide any public work (subject as to Railways to Section 96), and such authorisation shall be deemed an authority to such Minister by and under that Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the power conferred by the recited section of "The Public Works Act, 1902," doth hereby authorise the Honourable Minister for Works to undertake, construct, and provide a building for the purposes of the State Savings Bank at Subiaco, on the land shown coloured green on Plan P.W.D., W.A., 25388 (L.T.O. Diagram 7709), which may be inspected at the office of the Minister for Works, Perth.

The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

M.W.S. 333/25.

WHEREAS by "The Metropolitan Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1909," it is provided that, subject to the provisions of the Act, the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage shall, with the approval of the Governor, have power to construct and extend waterworks, sewerage works, and stormwater drainage works: And whereas the preliminary requirements of the said Act have been complied with, and plans, sections, and estimates in respect of the works hereinafter mentioned have been submitted to and approved by the Governor in Council: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, does hereby empower the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage to undertake the construction of the following works under the said Act, namely:—

Metropolitan Sewerage.

Area 36, Perth District, 9-inch, 6-inch, and 4-inch reticulation sewers, with all manholes, inspection shafts, and all other apparatus connected therewith, as shown in red and brown on Plan M.W.S., S., & D.D., W.A., No. 4456, deposited at the office of the Minister.

This Order in Council shall take effect from the 16th day of September, 1927.

The Road Districts Act, 1919.

Kalgoorlie Road District—Alteration of Boundary with Boulder Municipality.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

BOAT LICENSING ACT, 1878, AND AMENDMENTS.

Amendment of Regulations.

The Regulations made by the Fremantle Boat Licensing Board are hereby amended by adding the following new regulation, viz.:—

All Accidents or Harmful Occurrences to be Reported.

The owner, and also the master or coxswain, of every steamer, vessel, or boat licensed by the Fremantle Boat Licensing Board for the carriage of passengers or goods (either or both) shall without any delay report in writing to the Board any accident to the said steamer, vessel, or boat, or any occurrence or happening or condition which may have occurred or arisen the effect of which tended to cause such steamer, vessel, or boat to become or expected to become unseaworthy, leaky, dangerous, or in any way likely to have or produce any deleterious or harmful effect upon any passenger or cargo (either or both) carried or to be carried.

Any license issued by the Board and still effective shall, concurrently with the occurrence, become automatically null and void and shall remain so until re-issued. It shall be sent to the Board with the reports provided for and the Board will then have an examination made by its Surveyor, and may, on his report, order certain work to be done or repairs or alterations to be carried out by the owner or licensee, and upon their completion to the satisfaction of the Board the license shall be reissued. All expenses of survey shall be borne by the owner of the said steamer, vessel, or boat.
