Sheep.—Only sheep kept for killing by *bona fide* butchers trading in Broome for supplying the public shall be allowed to run and depasture on the Common, and shall be charged at the rate of 2d. per head per calendar month or part thereof. No one firm of butchers shall depasture more than fifty sheep at any one time, except by special permission of the Board.

BARMAIDS AND BARMEN.
(Registered 19/9/27.)

No. 22 of 1927.

THIS Agreement, made in pursuance of "The Industrial Arbitration Act, 1912-1925," this ninth day of September, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, between the Western Australian Barmaids and Barmen's Union of Workers, Perth, W.A. (hereinafter called the "Union"), of the one part, and persons whose signatures appear in the schedule hereto, Licensed Victuallers carrying on business in the State of Western Australia (hereinafter called the "Employers"), of the other part, witnesseth that for the consideration hereinafter appearing, the parties hereto mutually covenant and agree the one with the other as follows:—

Definitions.

1. In this schedule, and unless the context otherwise indicates, and without limiting the ordinary meaning of the term, "Barmaid" or "Barman" means any person over the age of twenty-one (21) years employed in the sale of liquor by retail in any hotel licensed under a publican's general license, hotel license, or wine and beer license. Provided that any employee other than a barmaid or barman may sell liquor for not more than two (2) hours per day between the hours of twelve (12) noon and three (3) p.m., and/or five (5) p.m. and seven (7) p.m.

Wages.

Basic Wage £4 5s. per week for males; £2 5s. 11d. per week for females.

2. The wages of a barmaid or barman shall be five pounds three shillings (£5 3s.) per week, without board and lodging, and shall be paid weekly.

Where the Board of Reference or the Union grants a permit for the employee to lodge and/or board on the premises of the employer, the sum of one pound five shillings (£1 5s.) may be deducted from the hereinbefore stipulated wages for board and lodging charges.

Residence.

3. Except as hereinbefore provided, no barmaid or barman shall board and/or reside upon the premises of the employer by whom she or he is employed.

The above shall not apply to:—

- any barmaid or barman who is the son or daughter of the licensee of the hotel in which she or he is working;
- any hotel for which the Board of Reference or the Union grants a permit for an employee or employees to lodge and/or board on the premises of the employer.

The Board of Reference shall consist of the Secretary of the Licensed Victuallers' Association, the Secretary of the Western Australian Barmaids' and Barmen's Union, with the Clerk of the Arbitration Court as Chairman.

Hours.

4. All work done in excess of forty-eight (48) hours in any one week, or of nine (9) hours in any one day, shall be paid for at the rate of time and a third, such overtime rates to stand alone and be paid for separate and apart from the ordinary week's wages: Provided that not more than three nine-hour days may be worked in any one week.

Christmas Day, Good Friday, Sunday, Labour Day, and Anzac Day.

5. All work done on Christmas Day, and Good Friday and Sunday, shall be paid for at the rate of three shillings per hour, or portion of an hour, in addition to the weekly wage. All work done on Anzac Day and Labour Day be paid for at the rate of time and a third, provided that Anzac Day remains as at present—virtually a Sunday in the trade. Should the present conditions under which it is honoured be altered, then the provision for payment of time and a third for that day be discharged automatically from this Agreement. Any overtime worked on Labour Day shall stand alone and be paid for separately and apart from the ordinary week's wages.

Race, Show, Sports, and Casual Hands.

6. A barmaid or barman employed in booths on race-courses or at show grounds, or as extra hand at hotels for sports gatherings, shall be paid at the rate of twenty-two shillings and sixpence (22s. 6d.) per shift of not more than eight (8) hours.

Where a licensed house is situated near an evening place of amusement, a casual barmaid or barman may be employed at the rate of five shillings (5s.) per hour, with a minimum payment of ten shillings (10s.).

All work done in excess of eight (8) hours in any one day shall be paid for at the rate of time and one-third.

A barmaid or barman employed at the Trotting Grounds shall be paid at the rate of two shillings and sixpence (2s. 6d.) per hour, with a minimum of ten shillings (10s.). The time for starting work shall be the time she or he is told to be at the grounds.

Uniform.

7. Where the employers insist upon a barmaid or barman wearing a uniform whilst at work, the employer shall provide and maintain the same in a reasonable state of cleanliness. Should the washing of white coats be done by arrangement at the cost of the employee, the sum of two shillings and sixpence (2s. 6d.) shall be provided by the employer per week to defray this cost.

Meal Time.

8. A barmaid or barman shall be allowed one hour between the hours of twelve (12) noon and three (3) o'clock in the afternoon for dinner; and on every evening when required to work after half-past six (6.30) o'clock, one hour between the hours of five (5) and eight (8) o'clock for tea.

Weekly half-holiday.

9. The weekly half-holiday shall commence not later than one thirty (1.30) p.m. on some one week day in each week.

Holidays and Annual Leave.

10. A barmaid or barman shall be entitled to two weeks' leave on full pay after the expiration of each twelve (12) months' service. Such leave may be applied for at any time after it becomes due, and in no case shall the money be paid instead of the holiday. A barmaid or barman whose services have been terminated before twelve (12) months have expired shall be entitled to payment for one day for each calendar month worked.

Notice.

11. Twenty-four hours' notice of termination of employment shall be given by either side.

Term.

12. This Agreement shall operate for a period of three (3) years from its date of issue. Either party may, after twelve (12) months from the date of execution, apply to the Court of Arbitration to amend, alter, or revise the same.

Record Book.

13. Each employer shall keep or cause to be kept at his business premises record books, in which shall be entered the name of each worker, the time each worker commences and ceases work each day, the total number of hours and the amount of overtime worked, the time worked on a Christmas Day, Good Friday, Anzac Day, Labour Day, and on any Sunday, and the amount of wages and overtime paid, and the worker's signature for the same.

The worker and the employer shall be jointly responsible for the proper posting of the record books daily.

Such record books shall be so kept as to be open to and available for inspection by an accredited representative of the Union during business hours.

Schedule of Wages and Working Conditions.

14. Each employer shall keep on some portion of his business premises a copy of this schedule of wages and working conditions, where it shall be open to the inspection of the worker at all reasonable times.

Area.

15. This Agreement shall apply to the areas comprised within the following Licensing Districts of Western Australia:—

Northam, Toodyay, that portion of the Swan Licensing District outside of 20 miles radius of the G.P.O., Perth (being the area covered by Industrial Agreement No. 37/1924), Murray-Wellington, Forrest, Bunbury, Sussex, and Nelson.

Common Rule.

16. All parties to this industrial agreement hereby agree to have the same made a Common Rule.
