THE ROAD DISTRICTS ACT, 1919.

Gascoyne-Minilya Road District-Alteration of Boundaries with Ashburton Road District.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 559/27. WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," the Governor may by Order in Council sever any portion of a Road District and annex it to an existing Road District; and whereas it is desirable to sever portion of the Ashburton Road District and annex it to the Gascoyne-Minilya Road District: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, under the provisions of the said Act and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby sever that portion of the Ashburton Road District, as described in the Schedule hereto, and annex it to the Gascoyne-Minilya Road District.

Gascoyne-Minitya Road District—Transfer of territory from the Ashburton Road District.

The Stock Diseases Act, 1895. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by Section 6 of "The Stock Diseases Act, 1895, the Governor is empowered by Order in Council, to be published in the Government Gazette, from time to time to make, vary, alter, or revoke such regulations under the said Act as may be deemed necessary for any of the purposes mentioned in the said Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, does hereby make additional regulations to the Stock Diseases Regulations, 1926, published in the Government Gazette of the 5th day of August, 1927, as follows:—

Kalgoorlie Quarantine Area for Swine.

67a. (1) All that area situated within a circle having a radius of five miles from the Town Hall at Kalgoorlie is hereby established and declared to be a quarantine area.

(2) No pig and no pig products shall be removed

from the said quarantine area.

- (3) No pig shall be removed from one place to another in the said quarantine area, except to a local abattoir, with the authority of an Inspector of Stock; and the transport of pigs to an abattoir shall be by means of a vehicle with an impervious floor and not otherwise.
- (4) No local pigswill or kitchen refuse shall be used for the purpose of feeding pigs within the said quarantine area, unless such pigswill or kitchen refuse has been boiled before being so used.
- (5) Any person who commits a breach of any of the foregoing provisions of this regulation shall be liable on conviction to a penalty not exceeding twenty pounds.

Introduction of Frozen Pork. Hogs' Hair, and other Pig By-products into this State.

- Frozen pork, hogs' hair, and other pig byproducts shall not be imported into this State any other State in the Commonwealth of Australia except under and subject to the following conditions, namely:
- (1) Frozen pork shall be accompanied by a certificate signed by a Government Veterinary Officer of the State of origin that the carcases are those of animals which have not been affected with swine fever and have not been in contact with animals suffering with swine
- (2) Hogs' hair and other pig by-products shall be accompanied by a certificate signed by a Government Veterinary Officer of the State of origin that the said products have been treated by a recognised process of sterilisation and are not the products from animals affected with swine fever.
