### WEIGHTS AND MEASURES ACT, 1915.

Amendment of Regulations.

The Regulations under "The Weights and Measures Act, 1915," published in the Government Gazette on the 3rd day of June, 1927, are hereby amended as follows:—

- A provise is added to Regulation 111 as follows: Provided that paragraph (b) shall not apply to petrol pumps erected before the 1st day of July, 1927.
- 2. A proviso is added to Regulation 124, and shall be deemed to have been inserted in the said regulations from the commencement thereof, as follows:

Provided also that the mileage fee may be remitted by the Commissioner in his discretion when the means of conveyance are provided by and at the cost of the manufacturer, seller, repairer, owner, or user, as the case may be.
