WYALKATCHEM ROAD DISTRICT.

*Description of Ward Boundaries.*

*Central Ward.*

Bounded on the Northward by lines commencing at the North-West corner of Lot 235, and extending Eastward along the Northern boundaries of Lots 235, 236, and 232, and continuing to the West boundary of Reserve 688.

2. On the Eastward by part of the West boundary of said Reserve 688, part of the North and the West boundary of Reserve 15697 and through Location 16626 to the production East of the North boundary of Location 8742.

3. On the Southward by the production and North boundary of said Location 8742, part of the South-Eastern, an East and Southernmost boundary of Reserve 15044 to the North-East corner of Location 16155.

Lot 65 aforesaid, the Western and Southern boundaries of Lot 81, the East boundary of Reserve 9280, the North boundary of Lot 32, the Western boundaries of

Lots 32, 31, 30, 150, 28, 104, 105, 108, 106, and Avon Locations 15748, 21695, 22825, 10853, 15751, and 10852, and the latter's production through Location 17808 to the North boundary of the Central Ward; thence by parts of the North and West boundaries of the Central Ward to the Southern side of the Dowerin-Merredin Railway Reserve.

3. On the Southward by said Railway Reserve, the South boundaries of Locations 9530 and 11762, and a West and a South boundary of the last-mentioned location, the East and North boundaries of Location 11608, the Westernmost boundary of Location 18886, parts of the South and West boundaries of Benjaberring town-site, the North and part of the West boundary of Location 16583, and the North boundaries of Locations 8942 and 8941 to the starting point. (One member.)

*Coweowing Ward.*

Bounded on the Northward by part of the district boundary from its intersection with the East boundary of the Benjaberring Ward and the North-Eastern corner of Coweowing A.A. Lot 169.

2. On the Eastward by lines commencing at the last-mentioned intersection, and extending Southward along the Eastern boundaries of Coweowing A.A. Lots 169, 91, 56, 78, 58, 232, 233, 279, and 210, through Lot 60, along the Eastern boundaries of Avon Locations 20958, 20811, and through Location 17130, the Easternmost, South, and an East boundary of Location 15738, part of the North and East boundary of Location 15736, the East boundary of Location 15737, through, and along an East boundary of Location 18210; thence Eastward along the Southern side of the surveyed road, passing through Location 15750 to the production North of the East boundary of Location 10195, again South along the production of the East boundary of Location 10195, the East boundary of Location 10196, continuing to the Southern side of the Dowerin-Merredin Railway Reserve.

3. On the Southward by the said side of Railway Reserve, parts of the East, South, and part of the West boundary of Location 11629, again by the Southern side of the Railway Reserve, the North boundary of Location 18432, the East boundary of Location 11782 to the Eastern boundary of the Central Ward.

4. On the Westward by part of the boundaries of the Central Ward and the East boundary of the Coweowing Ward to the starting point. (One member.)

*Wyalkatchem Ward.*

Bounded on the Northward by parts of the boundaries of Benjaberring, Central, and Coweowing Wards to the production North of the Eastern boundary of Location 15712.

2. On the Eastward by the production of the East boundary of said Location 15712 and the East boundaries of Locations 20966, 15717, 26032, 11677, 11679, 12919, 12908, 11676, 12898, 11681, part of the North and East boundary of Reserve 10992, a West, a North, and the Westernmost boundary of Location 20955, part of the North, the West, and part of the South boundary of Location 20194, the West boundaries of Locations 11469 and 11470, and part of the latter's South boundary, the West, and part of the South boundary of Location 11517, the West boundary of Locations 11519 and 24734 to the district boundary.

3. On the South and Westward by part of the district boundary to the starting point. (Three members.)

*Korrelocking Ward.*

Bounded on the Northward by part of the Coweowing and Wallambin Wards.

On the Eastward and Southward by part of the District boundary.

On the Westward by the East boundary of the Wyalkatchem Ward. (Two members.)

*Wallambin Ward.*

Bounded on the Northward and Eastward by part of the district boundary from its intersection with the Coweowing Ward to the South-East corner of Location 12285.

2. On the Southward by lines commencing at the said South-East corner, and extending Westward along the South and East boundary of Location 12285 aforesaid to the Dowerin-Merredin Railway Reserve, and along said side of the Railway Reserve to the East boundary of the Coweowing Ward.

On the Westward by the East boundary of the Coweowing Ward to the starting point. (One member.)

## ARMADALE-KELMSCOTT ROAD DISTRICT.

*Description of Ward Boundaries.**Kelmscott Ward.*

Bounded by lines commencing at the intersection of the Northern side of Road No. 2609 with the right bank of the Canning River and extending Southward along said bank of the river to the South corner of Lot 26, and along the South-Eastern boundary of the said lot to its Eastern corner; thence to the South-West corner of Canning Location 331 and along part of its South boundary to the production North of the West boundary of Sub-Lot 150; thence South along said production and West boundary and the West boundaries of Sub-Lots 149, 148, 124, 123, 122, 121, and 114, and the South-Western boundaries of Sub-Lots 114 and 115, to the Western corner of Lot 101; thence Westward to and along the North boundaries of Lots 102, 103, 104, 158, 163, and 162 and the North boundary of Lot 132 of Location 31, continuing to the Western side of the Perth-Bunbury road (No. 122); thence Northward along said side of the road to the South side of Road No. 3843 (Foster Road), and along said South side to the Western side of the South-Western Railway Reserve, and Northward along said Railway Reserve to the production South-Eastward of the South-Western side of Road No. 3830 (First Road); thence North-Westward along said production and South-Western side of Road No. 3830 and the South-Western side of Road No. 1053 to the South-Eastern boundary of Location 30, and North-Eastward along part of the said South-Eastern boundary to the Western side of the Railway Reserve, and along said side of the Railway Reserve to the production South-Westward of the North-Western side of Road No. 2609; thence North-Eastward along the said production and North-Western side of Road No. 2609 to the starting point. (1 member.)

*Armada Ward.*

Bounded by lines commencing at the intersection of the Western side of the South-Western Railway Reserve with the production West of the North side of Road No. 3845 (Rogers Lane) and extending Eastward along said production and North side of Road No. 3845 to Road No. 122; thence Eastward and Southward along the townsite boundary to the North boundary of Lot 157 of Location 31, and along part of the Northern and the East boundaries of said Lot 157 and the latter boundary's production South to intersect an East and West line passing through the intersection of the Northern side of Road No. 4592 with the East side of the Perth-Bunbury Road; thence West along said East and West lines to the production North of the East boundary of Lot 1 (as shown on L.T.O. Plan 4956); thence South along said production and the East boundaries of Lots 1 to 22 inclusive, and West along the South boundary of the last mentioned lot and its production West to the West side of the Perth-Bunbury Road, and Northward along said side of the road to the South boundary of the townsite, and Westward along said Southern boundary to the South corner of Lot 58 of Location 31, and along the South-Western boundaries of Lots 58 and 59, the South-East and North-East boundary of Lot 60, the South-East and the North-East boundary of Lot 48, the North-East boundary

of Lot 47, part of the South-East boundary of Lot 46, the South-East boundaries of Lots 41 and 33, continuing to the starting point. (2 members.)

*Forrestdale Ward.*

Bounded on the Westward and North-Eastward by part of the district boundary from the South-West corner of Peel Estate Lot 689 to the South corner of Location 16a.

On the Eastward by lines commencing at the said South corner and extending Southward to and along the South-Western boundary of Jandakot A.A. Lot 84, the North-Western boundaries of Lots 82, 81, and 78, and part of the South-Western boundary of the last-mentioned, the North-West, and a South-West boundary of Lot 75, part of the North-Western and the South-Western boundaries of Location 470, the West boundaries of Lots 3 and 4, the South boundaries of Lots 4 and 2, the West boundaries of Location 637 and 636 to the South-West corner of the last-mentioned location.

On the Southward by lines commencing at the said South-West corner and extending Westward along the South boundaries of Peel Estate Lots 185 and 184 and part of the West boundary of the latter, the Southern boundaries of Lots 180, 177, and 178, part of the East boundary of Lot 694, the East boundaries of Lots 102 and 106, the South-Eastern and the South boundary of Lot 107, and the South boundary of Lot 689 to the starting point. (1 member.)

*West Ward.*

Bounded on the Eastward by lines commencing at the intersection of the Western side of the South-Western Railway Reserve with the district boundary, and extending Southward along said side of the Railway Reserve to the boundaries of Kelmscott Town Ward; thence by the Western boundaries of the Kelmscott Town Ward and again by the Western side of the Railway Reserve to the North-Westward boundaries of the Armada Ward; thence by the Western and part of the Southern boundaries of the Armada Ward, and again along the Western side of the Railway Reserve to intersect the production East of the North boundary of Canning Location 529.

2. On the Southward and Westward by lines commencing at the said intersection and extending West along the North boundary of said Location 529 and the North boundary of Serpentine A.A. Lot 6, the West boundary of Location 336, part of the West boundary of Location 401, the South boundaries of Locations 555 and 636 to the East boundary of the Forrestdale Ward.

3. On the Westward by the East boundary of the Forrestdale Ward to the South corner of Location 16a; thence by part of the district boundary to the starting point. (2 members.)

*Roleystone Ward.*

On the Eastward by lines commencing at the said North-East corner and extending Southward along part of the East boundary of said Location 473, the North and Eastern boundaries of Location 613, parts of the North and East boundaries of Location 33, the North and part of the East boundary of Location 523, the North and East boundaries of Location 558, part of the East boundary of Location 615 to the production West of the South boundary of Location 443; thence along said production and South boundary and its production East to intersect the production North of the West boundary of Location 433 and South along the latter production, and the West and part of the South boundaries of Location 433 aforesaid to the production North of the East boundary of Location 348; thence South along the last-mentioned production and the East boundary of Location 348 to the South-East corner of the last-mentioned location.

On the Southward by lines commencing at the last-mentioned South-East corner and extending Westward along the South boundary of Location 348 and its production West to the East boundary of Reserve 4127, and North along part of the East boundary of the said Reserve and the East boundary of Location 681 to the North corner of the last-mentioned location; thence West to the South-East boundary of Lot 124 of Location 31 and along part of the South-East boundary of the said lot, the South boundaries of Lots 123, 122, and 116 to the South-West corner of the last-mentioned

lots; thence by part of the Northern boundary of the Armadale Ward to the Western side of the South-Western Railway Reserve.

4. On the Westward by part of the boundaries of the West and Kelmiscott Town Wards to the starting point. (2 members.)

*Karragullen Ward.*

Bounded on the Northward and Eastward by portion of the district boundary from its intersection with the Eastern boundary of the Roleystone Ward to intersect the production East of the South boundary of cancelled Lease No. 48/2344.

2. On the Southward by the production and South boundary of said cancelled Lease 48/2344 to its South-West corner.

3. On the Westward by part of the West boundary of the aforesaid cancelled lease and by the Eastern boundary of the Roleystone Ward to the starting point. (1 member.)

*Bedforddale Ward.*
