Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim and declare that the Victoria Plains Road Board may adopt the system of valuation on the annual value in that portion of its district described in the schedule hereto, and may impose rates on the rateable land within such area on the annual value thereof, in accordance with the relative provisions of the said Act and any Proclamation heretofore or hereafter issued thereunder and for the time being in force.

WHEREAS by Sections 222 and 227 of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1906" (6 Edwardi, No. 32), it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request of the Council, by notice in the Government Gazette to declare any land reserved, used, or by purchase or exchange acquired for a street or way, or any place, bridge, or thoroughfare, to be a public highway, and such land shall thereupon and theneeforth, from the date of such Proclamation, become and be absolutely dedicated to the public as a public highway within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force; and whereas the City of Perth Municipal Council has requested that certain land named and described in the Schedule hereunder, which has been reserved for a street or way within the City of Perth, be declared a public highway: Now, therefore I, the said Lieut.-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation declare the said land to be a public highway, and such land shall, from the date of this Proclamation, he absolutely dedicated to the public as a highway within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.

Wongan-Ballidu Road District—Description of Ward Boundaries.

Wongan Hills Ward.

### THE ROAD DISTRICTS ACT, 1919.

Plantagenet District Road Board.

BY-LAWS for the management and the use of the District Hall and other buildings under the control of the Board :-

1. Interpretation Clause .- In the construction of these By-laws-

(a) The word "Board" shall mean the Plantagenet Road Board.

(b) The word "building" shall mean and include any hall, room, or corridor and appurtenant premises of any such hall or building under the control of the Board.

Applications for the hire of the hall or other building shall be made in writing to the Secretary of the Board not less than 24 hours before the time that use is required. Applications to state the purpose for which the hall or other building is required.

3. The name and place of abode of the actual and

responsible person or persons hiring any building shall be given in the application.

4. The rent of the building and other fees, if any, shall be paid with each application, and shall be as set out in the schedule of charges as fixed by the Board.

The hours for which any building may be hired shall be as in the schedule of charges referred to in Bylaw No. 4 hereof.

- 6. The Board may at any time demand that the hirer shall, prior to the term of engagement, deposit an amount estimated to cover any damage that might occur during the term of such engagement.
- The Board reserves the right to refuse to let any building to any applicant for the hiring of it, without assigning any reason for such refusal.
- 8. The Board may at any time cancel any agreement made for the hiring of any building.
- 9. In the event of two or more applications being made for the hire of any building for the same date and hour, the Board may, without considering priority of application, determine to which applicant the hire of such building shall be granted.
- 10. The hirer of any building shall comply with the provisions of the Health Act, Entertainments Tax Act, and any other Act in force and applicable to such building. If in the opinion of the Board all the necessary actions have not been taken to comply with the provisions of the Acts above-mentioned, the Board may at any time prior to or during the term of engagement forbid and prevent the use of such building.
- 11. In the event of the use of any building being forbidden or prevented under the last preceding By-law, the hirer shall forfeit the full amount payable for the hire of such building as if the hire had been duly fulfilled, and the Board shall not be responsible to the hirer for any loss or damage incurred by the hirer.
- 12. No spirituous liquors, wine, ale, beer, porter, eider, or perry shall be brought into or consumed in any building during the term of engagement, except when permitted by the Board in writing
- 13. No person shall smoke any tobacco, eigar, eigarette, or objectionable substance, nor strike or otherwise ignite any light in any building during any ball or public entertainment, or at any gatherings of persons in the said buildings, whether such persons have been admitted by the payment of money or otherwise, except at a banquet or smoke social.
- 14. No person shall, in any part of the building or land appurtenant thereto enter or be—

(a) allowed to enter whilst intoxicated;
(b) be guilty of any misbehaviour whatsoever;

- (c) use profane or improper language;

- (d) damage, mark, or deface any shrub, tree, flowers, grass, fence, gates, wall or other part of the building, or the furniture or fittings thereof. Any person who does, permits, or suffers any such damage shall be liable to pay the cost of such damage in addition to any penalty imposed by these By-laws;
- (e) stand, loiter, or cause any obstruction whatsoever in the passage-ways of any building. Any persons so doing shall immediately disperse on being requested so to do by the Secretary or other duly authorised officer of the Board, or police constable, whether in uniform or otherwise.
- No offensive impersonations or representations of living persons, nor anything calculated to produce a disturbance, riot, or breach of the peace shall be permitted in any building.

The hirer of any building shall be responsible

for-

(a) maintaining good order and enforcing these By-

(b) any damage done to the building, fixtures, fittings, furniture, or crockeryware or other part of the property.

The Secretary of the Board or other duly au-

thorised officer of the Board, or police constable, shall be permitted to have free ingress to any building or part thereof at all times during the term of engage-ment, and every facility shall be given them for en-

ment, and every facility shall be given them for enforcing these By-laws.

18. Every person who does, permits, or suffers any act, matter, or thing contrary to any of these By-laws, or commits or permits any breach or neglect thereof shall be deemed guilty of an offence against these By-laws and shall be lighly to a popular not exceeding 420. laws, and shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding £20

for every such offence.


