## PORT OF FREMANTLE. <br> Gage Roads to Owen Anchorage. <br> Channel across Success Bank. <br> NOTICE TO MARINERS.

FURTHER to notice to Mariners issued by the Fremantle Harbour Trust Commissioners dated 28th March, 1927, and published in the Government Gazette of 1st April, 1927, and to Notice issued similarly dated 22nd June, 1928, and published in the Government Gazette of Gth July, 1928, the chamnel across Snccess Bank has again been sounded and compass bearings of the channel checked.

Navigators have reported that their vessels tended to sheer in the channel about 2,000 feet distant from the Northern entrance buoys. Somndings taken over this spot have revealed a bank, apparently of sand, extending for some 600 feet along the Western edge of the channel, from about 2,000 feet from the Northern entrance buoys to about 2,600 feet along the chamel, and extending into the clannel to about half-way between its Western edge and the centre line. The least water found on this bank was 18 feet 6 inches at low water.

As it evidently is the existence of this bank that caused the tendency to sheer, which had been reported, mariners are advised to keep as far away from it as possible, and to watch carefully the actions of their slips when passing it.
The compass bearing of this channel has again been checked, and it is found to be $170^{\circ}$ True, corresponding with South $5^{\circ}$ East Magnetic.
