GOVERNMENT TENDER BOARD.

It is hereby published, for general information, that His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council has approved of the amendment of Tender Board Regulation No. 41, as follows:—

Regulation 41.

(a) As far as possible all purchases by Stores shall be of the kind specified in the Tender Board contracts or in the price lists of the manufacturing Departments of the Government.

(b) Purchase of stores not under contract, to the value of not more than twenty-five pounds (£25) for any one (1) line, may be made by the Controller of Stores, upon whom, on receipt of requisitions, it shall be incumbent to obtain written quotations from all leading firms doing business in the class of goods to be purchased. The quotation forms shall specify the time of closing, and the quotations shall be submitted, under cover of a sealed envelope, and opened in the presence of two (2) officers at the specified time, and duly initialed by them. Where the value of an order does not exceed one pound (£1), written quotations may be dispensed with. The quotations obtained must be produced for the Board's inspection and information whenever required. The Controller of Stores may, at his discretion, dispense with quotations where immediate purchase is rendered necessary to supply an urgent Government requirement. When passing accounts for payment under this paragraph Departments must quote thereon as their authority for the expenditure "T.B. 41 (b)."

(c) Purchase of stores not under contract or not more than one thousand pounds (£1,000) may be made by Controller of Stores in the same manner as above, on the authority of the Board. The applications (Form 2) must be forwarded in triplicate, the quotations obtained being attached to one copy. When passing accounts for payment under this paragraph the Department must quote thereon as their authority for the expenditure the Tender Board number, which will be given on the approved application. The Controller of Stores may, at his discretion, purchase supplies in anticipation of Tender Board approval: provided that, in all such cases, quotations have been obtained in accordance with these regulations and the lowest quotation for the quality required accepted. Such purchase must be submitted to the Tender Board, on Form 3, for confirmation at the meeting next following such purchases. The Form 3 shall contain a certificate, signed by the Controller of Stores, that the Tender Board Regulations have been complied with in all

respects. In cases where urgent purchases are necessary to meet Government requirements, the Controller of Stores may, at his discretion, purchase in anticipation of Tender Board approval and without obtaining quotations: provided that each of such cases is referred to the Board, with explanatory note, on Form 3, for confirmation at the meeting next following such purchase.

(d) Purchase of stores not under contract amounting to more than one thousand pounds (£1,000) may be recommended to the Governor in Council, through the Treasurer. The application, Form 3, must be forwarded in triplicate, the quotations obtained being attached to one copy. When passing accounts for payment under this paragraph departments must quote thereon as their authority for the expenditure the Tender Board number, which will be given on the approved application.

(e) On the recommendation of the Board, through the Treasurer, to the Governor in Council, exemptions from this regulation may be allowed.

The following transactions do not require the approval of the Tender Board:—

1. Purchase of supplies by Government Departments from State Trading Concerns.
2. Purchase of hessian, stockinette and tin plates by the Wyndham Meat Works.
3. Inter-departmental purchases, *i.e.*, purchases by one Department from another.

His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council has amended Public Service Regulation 77 by deleting Clause (e) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:—

(e) District allowances may, with the approval of the Permanent Head, be granted to officers temporarily located in towns where officers permanently residing therein are paid such allowance; provided they are required to remain in such towns for a period of not less than one month from November to March inclusive.

District allowance may also be paid, with the approval of the Permanent Head, to officers engaged for a like period in active field duties adjacent to such towns at any time of the year.

By-laws of the Melville Road Board.

Advertising Hoardings, Signboard, Placards, or any Structure erected of this nature.

P.W. 4876/21.

IN pursuance of the powers in that behalf contained in Section 196 of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," the Melville Road Board doth hereby make the following By-laws:—

1. Repeal.—All by-laws hitherto made by the Melville Road Board with reference to matters herein contained are hereby repealed.

2. Interpretation Clause.—In the construction of this By-law:—

- (a) The word "occupier" shall mean the person having the use or control of a hoarding, signboard, or placard;
- (b) The words "hoarding," "signboard," or "placard," or any structure erected of this nature, shall mean a hoarding, signboard, placard, or structure erected on private property invested in the Board for the purpose of advertising;
- (c) The word "owner" shall mean the owner of the land on which the signboard, hoarding, or placard is erected;
- (d) The word "advertisement" shall mean and shall include any bills, posters, and all other advertisements of any nature stencilled, painted, or embossed and affixed or placed in any way on walls, fences, bridges, approaches, or windows;
- (e) The word "Board" shall mean the Melville District Road Board;
- (f) The word "Supervisor" shall mean any officer empowered by the Board for carrying out of this By-law.

Hoarding By-laws.

3. No person shall erect, or cause to be erected, a hoarding, signboard, or placard, unless and until a plan and specification showing clearly the position and size and method of, and the materials to be used in the construction of, and the manner of fixing same shall have been deposited with and approved by the Board.

4. No person shall make any alterations or additions to any hoarding, signboard, or placard unless or until the proposed alteration or addition has been approved by the supervisor.

5. If any hoarding, signboard, or placard is at any time in the opinion of the Board or supervisor in a dangerous or neglected condition, the owner or occupier shall, on receipt of a written notice to that effect, fail to forthwith remove or refix the same to the satisfaction of the supervisor, the Board may remove the same and recover the cost of doing so from the owner or occupier.

6. If in the opinion of the Board the hoarding, signboard, or placard shall become objectionable, the owner or occupier shall, upon receipt of a written notice to that effect, fail to at once remove or cause to be removed such hoardings, signboards, or placards, the supervisor or other person authorised by the Board shall remove same and recover cost of doing so from the owner or occupier.

7. All notices required by the By-law to be served on the owner or occupier shall, in the first place, be given to the occupier, but if he cannot be found, then such notice may be served on the owner.

8. If the owner or occupier of any hoarding, signboard, or placard fail to comply with the written order of the Board within the time named, then the supervisor may carry out the requirements of the order, and recover such costs as are incurred in the carrying out of the order.

9. No person shall erect any hoarding or signboard on any fence, wall, footpath, bridge, or approach to bridge, or in or on any window or any other portion of any building facing or abutting on any street or way or public place within the Melville Road Board District without the sanction of the Board.

10. Penalties.—Where anything in this By-law is directed to be done or forbidden to be done, or where authority is given to an officer to direct anything to be done or to forbid anything to be done, and such act forbidden to be done is done, in every case the person making default as to such direction and prohibition respectively shall be deemed guilty of a breach of this By-law, and shall be liable for every such offence, besides any other expenses which may be incurred in the taking of the proceedings against such person guilty of such offence, to a penalty not exceeding twenty pounds.
