WHEREAS by "The Game Act, 1912-13," it is provided that the Governor may from time to time by Proclamation declare any one or more portions of the State or any one or more localities to be respectively defined in such Proclamation a Reserve for Native Game or any particular Native Game: Now, therefore I, the said Governor, in exercise of the power aforesaid, do hereby, with the advice of the Executive Council, declare that the portions of the State and localities mentioned and defined in the Schedule hereto shall be a Reserve for Native Game.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Cemeteries Act, 1897," it is made lawful for the Governor in Executive Council from time to time by Proclamation to appoint such place or places in each district as shall be deemed expedient to be reserved for the burial of the dead: Now, therefore I, Sir William Robert Campion, Governor of the said State, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, in exercise of the powers in me vested as aforesaid, do by this my Proclamation appoint Reserve 14614, at Yealering, a Public Cemetery, under the provisions of the said Act, but subject always to such regulations as may be published from time to time for the proper management of the same.

AT a meeting of the Executive Council held at the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, this 30th day of October, 1928, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

*The Land Act, 1898.*

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Corr. No. 785/00.

WHEREAS by Section 42 of "The Land Act, 1898," it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any Reserve shall vest in and be held by any Municipality, Road Board, or other person or persons to be named in the order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in Section 39 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order, and with power of leasing for any term not exceeding twenty-one years from the date of the lease: And whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve 7135, at North Bunbury, should vest in and be held by the Municipality of Bunbury: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the before-mentioned Reserve shall vest in and be held by the Municipality of Bunbury, with power to the said Municipality of Bunbury to lease the whole or any portion of the said Reserve for any term not exceeding ten years from the date of the lease, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to the Governor by Section 41 of the Act.

WHEREAS by Section 42 of "The Land Act, 1898," it is made lawful for the Governor to direct that any Reserve shall vest in and be held by any Municipality, Road Board, or other person or persons to be named in the order, in trust for any of the purposes set forth in

Section 39 of the said Act, or for the like or other public purposes to be specified in such order: And whereas it is deemed expedient that Reserve No. 19940 (Jilbadji Location 382) should vest in and be held by the Hon. Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage in trust for the purpose of Water: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that the before-mentioned Reserve shall vest in and be held by the Hon. Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage in trust for the purpose aforesaid, subject nevertheless to the powers reserved to him by Section 41 of the said Act.

*The Cemeteries Act, 1897, and Amendments.*

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

5956/24.

WHEREAS by the provisions of "The Cemeteries Act, 1897," and amendments it is made lawful (in case it would appear to the Governor that burials in any Cemetery under law relating to public cemeteries or other burial ground or place of burial whatsoever shall be wholly discontinued, or should be discontinued subject to any exception or qualification) for the Governor, by Order to be published in the *Government Gazette* to direct that, after a time to be mentioned in such Order, not being less than three months from the date thereof, burials in any cemetery or burial place, ground or place of burial shall be discontinued wholly or subject to any exception or qualifications mentioned in the same or in any subsequent Order: And whereas it has been made to appear to the said Governor that it is advisable that all burials should be discontinued in the old Church of England Cemetery at Bunbury, being Bunbury Lot 294, except in such cases where persons desiring to bury therein can produce their title to an area in such cemetery: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby direct that, from and after the 26th day of January, 1929, burials within the limits of the said Cemetery shall be discontinued except in cases where persons desiring to bury therein can produce title to an area of land in the said Cemetery.

*Municipality of Busselton.*

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 1601/27.

WHEREAS the Busselton Municipality was divided into three Wards by Order in Council published in the *Government Gazette* on the 31st day of August, 1928; and whereas it is provided by Subsection 13 of Section 12 of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1906," that the Governor may by Order in Council declare the number of the population of any municipal district; and whereas it is necessary to declare the number of the population in the said Busselton Municipality for the purpose of ascertaining, under the provisions of Section 11 of the said Act, the number of Councillors to be elected for each of the said three Wards: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare the number of the population of the said Busselton Municipality to be under one thousand.

*The Road Districts Act, 1919.*

*Carnamah Road District—Alteration of Boundaries with Mingenew, Morawa, Perenjori, Irwin, and Dalwallinu Road Districts, and formation of the Three Springs Road District.*

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 1215/27.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," the Governor may by Order in Council sever any portion of a Road District and annex it to an existing Road District, or constitute such severed portion a Road District, and divide a Road District into Wards; and whereas it is desirable to amend the boundaries of the Carnamah, Mingenew, Morawa, Perenjori, Irwin, and Dalwallinu Road Districts as described in

the Schedules hereto: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, under the provisions of "The Road Districts Act, 1919," doth hereby—

- (1) sever that portion of the Carnamah Road District, described in Schedule "A" hereto, and annex it to the Morawa Road District;
- (2) sever that portion of the Mingenew Road District, described in Schedule "B" hereto, and annex it to the Morawa Road District;
- (3) sever that portion of the Irwin Road District, described in Schedule "C" hereto, and annex it to the Mingenew Road District;
- (4) sever that portion of the Carnamah Road District, described in Schedule "D" hereto, and annex it to the Perenjori Road District;
- (5) sever that portion of the Carnamah Road District, described in Schedule "E" hereto, and annex it to the Dalwallinu Road District;
- (6) sever that portion of the Irwin Road District, described in Schedule "F" hereto, and annex it to the Carnamah Road District;
- (7) sever that portion of the Mingenew Road District, described in Schedule "G" hereto, and annex it to the Carnamah Road District;
- (8) sever that portion of the Carnamah Road District (as amended by Schedules "A," "D," "E," "F," and "G"), described in Schedule "H" hereto and constitute such severed portion a Road District, to be called the Three Springs Road District;
- (9) Redivide the Mingenew Road District, when so amended, into five Wards, with the names and boundaries as described in Schedule "K" hereto;
- (10) divide the Three Springs Road District into five Wards, with the names and boundaries as described in Schedule "L" hereto.

To come into force on the 1st day of January, 1929.

#### Schedule A.

*Morawa Road District—Transfer of Territory from the Carnamah Road District.*

All the piece of land bounded by lines commencing on the present district boundary at the North-Western corner of Lot M1582 of Victoria Location 2018 and extending Eastward and Southward along part of the said district boundary to the North-Western corner of Lot M1646; thence West to the East boundary of Lot M1655, and North along part of said Eastern boundary to the production East of the South boundary of Lot M1582 and along said production and South boundary and the West boundary of Lot M1582 aforesaid to the starting point.

#### Schedule B.

*Morawa Road District—Transfer of Territory from the Mingenew Road District.*

All that piece of land bounded by lines commencing on the present district boundary at the South-Eastern corner of Victoria Location 1917 and extending Northward, Eastward, and Southward along part of the said district boundary to the South-Eastern corner of Lot M1458 of Location 2014; thence Westward along the South boundary and Northward along the Western boundary of said Lot M1458, a West boundary of Lot M1370, and a West and a South boundary of Lot M1351 to the starting point.

All that piece of land bounded by lines commencing at the South-East corner of Location 2017 and extending Northward along the East boundaries of the said location, part of the South, the West, and the North boundaries of Location 2016; thence Southward and Westward by part of the present district boundary to the starting point.

#### Schedule C.

*Mingenew Road District—Transfer of Territory from the Irwin Road District.*

All that portion of Victoria Location 2025 bounded on the Northward, Eastward, and Southward by part of the North, the East, and part of the South boundary of the said location and on the Westward by the production Southward of the Eastern boundary of Location 946.

#### Schedule D.

*Perenjori Road District—Transfer of Territory from the Carnamah Road District.*

All that piece of land bounded by lines commencing on the present district boundary at the North-Western corner of Lot M1646 and extending South-Eastward and Southward along the said district boundary to the North-Eastern corner of Lot M1525 of Victoria Location 2023; thence along the Southernmost, a West, a South, and a West boundary of Lot M1511, the Western boundary of Lot M1507 and again a West boundary of Lot M1511, part of the Southern and Western boundaries of Lot M1627, part of the Southern, a West, a South, and the Westernmost boundary of Lot M1647, part of the Southern, the East, and part of the North boundary of Lot M1644, the East and part of the North boundary of Lot M1663 of Location 2022, the East and North boundary of Lot M1739 to the South-Eastern side of Road No. 4803; thence North-Eastward along the said side of Road No. 4803 to the production South-Eastward of the South-Western boundary of Lot M 1628, and along the said production and South-Western boundary, part of the South boundary of Lot M 1578, the East and North boundaries of Lots M 1576 of Location 2021, the East boundaries of Lots M 1527 and M 1369, a South boundary of Lot M 1349, the South and West boundary of Lot M 1315 to the production Westward of the Northern boundary of Lot M 1646, and thence along the said production to the North-Western corner of Lot M 1646 (the starting point).

#### Schedule E.

*Dalwallinu Road District—Transfer of Territory from the Carnamah Road District.*

All that piece of land bounded on the Northward and Eastward by part of the present district boundary from its intersection with the Western boundary of Victoria Location 8187 to its intersection with the Southern boundary of Location 8459.

On the Southward by lines commencing at the last-mentioned intersection and extending Westward along part of the South boundary of said Location 8459, part of the East, the North, and part of the West boundary of Location 8448, a South boundary of Location 8620, the South boundary of a temporary reserve for water, the East boundary of Location 8575, part of the South and the West boundary of Location 8187 to the starting point.

#### Schedule F.

*Carnamah Road District—Transfer of Territory from the Irwin Road District.*

All that piece of land bounded on the Northward by lines commencing on the shores of the Indian Ocean and extending Eastward along the North and part of the East boundary of late Pastoral Lease 2193/93 to the production Westward of the Northern boundary of Pastoral Lease 2043/93 and along said production and last-mentioned North boundary, part of the West and North boundary of Pastoral Lease 1455/93, the Northern boundaries of Pastoral Leases 607/93 and 1047/93 to the North-Eastern corner of the last-mentioned lease; thence North to intersect the production Westward of the Southern boundary of Pastoral Lease 2496/93 and Eastward along the last-mentioned production to intersect the present district boundary.

On the Eastward, Southward, and Westward by part of the present district boundary to the starting point.

#### Schedule G.

*Carnamah Road District—Transfer of Territory from the Mingenew Road District.*

All that piece of land bounded by lines commencing at the intersection of the present district boundary with the centre line of Reserve 10876 (stock route) and extending Eastward along the said centre line of Reserve 10876 to the West boundary of Reserve 573 and along part of the West, the South, and part of the East boundary of said Reserve 573 and again along the centre line of Reserve 10876 aforesaid to the West boundary of Yandanooka Estate Lot 115; thence along part of the Western and the South boundary of said Lot 115 and the South boundaries of Lots 116 and 117, part of the West and the South boundary of Victoria Location 3306, the South and part of the Eastern boundary of Location 2486, the South boundaries of Lots M 327 and M 328 of Location 1929, the South boundary of Location 1726, the South boundary of Dudawa Estate Lot

40, the South boundaries of Location 1727 and of Lots M 329, M 330 and M 1263 of Location 1930 to the present district boundary; thence Southward, Westward, and Northward by the present district boundary to the Southern boundary of Location 2025 and along the last-mentioned Southern boundary to intersect the production South of the Eastern boundary of Location 946; thence North along the last-mentioned production to the starting point.

#### Schedule H.

##### *Three Springs Road District—Description of Boundaries.*

Bounded on the Northward by lines commencing at the intersection of the production South of the Eastern boundary of Victoria Location 946 with the centre line of Reserve 10876 (stock route) and extending Eastward along the said centre line to the West boundary of Reserve 573 and part of the West, the South and part of the East boundary of said Reserve 573 and again following the centre line of Reserve 10876 aforesaid to the West boundary of Yandanooka Estate Lot 115, part of the West and the South boundary of said Lot 115, the South boundaries of Lots 116 and 117, part of the West and South boundary of Victoria Location 3306, the South and part of the Eastern boundary of Location 2486, the Southern boundaries of Lots M 327 and M 328 of Location 1929, the South boundary of Location 1726 and of Dudawa Estate Lot 40, the South boundaries of Location 1727 and of Lots M 329, M 330 and M 1263 of Location 1930, the East boundaries of Lots M 1263 and M 331, the North boundary of Location 2018 to intersect the West boundary of Lot M 1582.

On the Eastward by lines commencing at the last-mentioned intersection and extending Southward along the Western boundary of Lot M 1582; thence along the South boundary of said lot and its production Eastward to intersect the West boundary of Lot M 1315, and along the said West boundary and the South boundaries of Lot M 1315 and of Lot M 1349 of Location 2079, the East boundaries of Lots M 1369 and M 1527, the North and East boundaries of Lot M 1576, the South boundaries of Lots M 1576 and M 1559 and the South boundaries of Lots M 1544 and M 1543, the West boundaries of Lots M 976, M 977 and M 978 of Location 2022, the South boundary of Lot M 853 and part of the South boundary of Lot M 947, the Easternmost, a South and an East boundary of Lot M 765, part of the North boundary of Victoria Location 7183 and to and along the North boundary of Location 7174 to the Western side of the Midland Railway Reserve and Northward along the said side of the Railway Reserve to the production Eastward of the South boundary of Location 3330; thence along the said production and South boundary and part of the West boundary of Location 3306 aforesaid, part of the South boundary of Location 8130 to the production Northward of the East boundary of Location 5621; thence to and along the East boundary of Location 5621, part of the North and the Easternmost boundary of Location 3053 and the last-mentioned boundary's production South to intersect the production East of the South boundary of Location 6273.

On the Southward by lines commencing at the last-mentioned intersection and extending Westward to and along the Southern boundary of Location 6273 aforesaid, part of the East and the South boundary of Location 7227 and the last-mentioned boundary's production West to intersect the production North of the Western boundary of Pastoral Lease 1171/93.

On the Westward by lines commencing at the last-mentioned intersection and extending Northward along the production North of the Western boundary of Pastoral Lease 1171/93 to the South boundary of Location 2025 and East along part of the South boundary of the said location to the production South of the East boundary of Location 946; thence along the last-mentioned production to the starting point. (Seven members allotted as in Schedule L.)

#### Schedule K.

##### *Mingenew Road District—Description of Ward Boundaries.*

##### Town Ward.

Bounded by lines commencing at the intersection of the North side of Road No. 5724 with the East boundary of Victoria Location 1539 and extending East along the said side of the road and along a South, a West, and the Southernmost boundary of Location 7854,

the North-Eastern, the East, the South, and the Westernmost boundary of Reserve 8356, a North and an East boundary of Location 2012, an East, a South, and part of the Easternmost boundary of Location 1539 to the starting point. (One member.)

##### North Ward.

Bounded on the Westward and Northward by part of the district boundaries from their intersection with the right bank of the Lockier River to the North-Eastern corner of Location 1908.

On the Eastward by part of the district boundary to the North-Eastern corner of Location 1905; thence along the East boundary of the last-mentioned location, parts of the North and West boundaries of Location 1906, the North boundaries of Guramu Estate Lots 2 and 1, and the Westernmost, the South, and a West boundary of the last-mentioned lot, part of the Southernmost boundary of Location 1903 to the production North of the West boundary of Location 1442; thence along the said production and West boundary to intersect the right bank of the Lockier River.

On the Southward by lines commencing at the last-mentioned intersection and extending Westward along the right bank of the Lockier River to the starting point. (One member.)

##### Guramu Ward.

Bounded on the Northward and Eastward by part of the district boundaries from the North-Eastern corner of Location 1905 to the North-Eastern corner of Yandanooka Estate Lot 70.

On the Southward by lines commencing at the North-Eastern corner of Yandanooka Estate Lot 70 and extending Westward along part of the North-Western boundary of the said Lot 70, the North-East and part of the North-West boundary of Lot 62, the North boundaries of Lots 67 and 68, part of the East boundary of Lot 31, the East boundaries of Lots 30 and 27 and the South and part of the West boundary of the last-mentioned lot, the North boundaries of Lots 4, 3, 2, and 1, and continuing Westward to intersect the Western side of the Midland Railway Reserve.

On the Westward by lines commencing at the last-mentioned intersection and extending Northward along the Western side of the Midland Railway Reserve to the Eastern boundary of the Town Ward; thence by part of the boundaries of the Town Ward and by the boundaries of Depot Hill Ward to the starting point. (Two members.)

##### Yandanooka Ward.

Bounded on the Northward by the South boundary of Guramu Ward and part of the district boundary to the North-Eastern corner of Yandanooka Estate Lot 70.

On the Eastward and Southward by part of the district boundary to the Eastern side of the Midland Railway Reserve.

On the Westward by the Eastern side of the Midland Railway Reserve to the starting point. (Two members.)

##### Lockier Ward.

Bounded on the Northward by part of the Southern boundary of Depot Hill Ward.

On the Eastward by the boundaries of the Town, Guramu, and Yandanooka Wards, and on the Southward and Westward by part of the district boundary to the starting point. (One member.)

#### Schedule L.

##### *Three Springs Road District—Description of Ward Boundaries.*

##### Three Springs Ward.

Bounded by lines commencing at the South corner of Lot M 748 of Location 2022 and extending along part of the South-Eastern boundary of the said lot, the South-Western boundary of Lot M 751, the North-Western boundary of Lot M 752 and the North-Western and North boundary of Kadathinni Agricultural Area Lot 11, part of the East boundary of Lot 12, the East and South-East boundaries of Lot 9 and continuing North-Eastward to the starting point. (One member.)

##### Arrino Ward.

Bounded on the Westward and Northward by part of the district boundary from the intersection of the production West of the South boundary of Victoria

Location 7227 with the production North of the Western boundary of Pastoral Lease 1171/93 to intersect the Eastern side of the Midland Railway Reserve.

On the Eastward by the said side of the Railway Reserve, part of a South, a West, and a North boundary of Lot M804 of Location 1932 and again along the Eastern side of the Railway Reserve to the production Eastward of the North boundary of Location 3521; thence along the said production and the North boundary, part of the South-Western boundary of Location 3763, the East boundaries of Locations 4853 and 6662, part of the North and the West boundary of Location 5176, part of the North, the West, and part of the South boundary of Location 6650, the Westernmost boundary of Location 6282, the West boundary of Location 6264, part of the North, the Westernmost, a South, and a West boundary of Location 4598, a West, a North, a West, a North, and the Westernmost boundary of Location 6753, part of the North boundary of Location 5283, the Easternmost boundary of Location 5973 to its South-Eastern corner.

On the Southward by lines commencing at the said South-Eastern corner and extending Westward along the Southernmost, a West, a South, and part of the Westernmost boundary of Location 5973, the South boundary of Location 4237 and its production Westward to the Eastern boundary of Pastoral Lease 2400/93, part of the East, the South, and a West boundary of said Pastoral Lease 2400/93, a South boundary of Pastoral Lease 2152/93, part of the East, South, and part of the West boundary of Location 5985, a South, an East, and the South boundary of Pastoral Lease 317/93, parts of the East and South boundaries of Location 3764, the East boundaries of Locations 2810 and 5984 and their production Southward to the district boundary and along said district boundary to the starting point. (One member.)

#### Dudawa Ward.

Bounded on the Northward and Eastward by part of the district boundary from its intersection with the Eastern boundary of the Arrino Ward to the North-Eastern corner of Lot M 1527 of Location 2020.

## BOILERMAKERS (STATE IMPLEMENT WORKS)

No. 23 of 1928.

THIS Agreement, made in pursuance of "The Industrial Arbitration Act, 1912-1925," this 25th day of September, 1928, between the Minister for Works and Labour (State Implement Works) (hereinafter referred to as "The Minister"), of the one part, and The Federated Society of Boilermakers and Structural Iron and Steel Workers' Coastal Districts Union, Western Australia (hereinafter referred to as "The Union"), of the other part, witnesseth that the parties hereto mutually covenant and agree the one with the other as follows:—

## 1.—Hours.

Forty-four hours shall represent a week's work. Such ordinary working hours shall not exceed eight hours on the first five days of the week and four hours on Saturdays.

## 2.—Overtime and Holidays.

(a) All time worked in excess of or outside the usual hours shall be paid at the rate of time and a half for the first four hours after usual stopping time, and double time thereafter: Provided that employees called to start work within an hour and a half of the usual starting time shall be paid at time and a half until the usual starting time.

(b) Systematic overtime shall not be worked. Overtime shall be considered systematic when two weeks' continuous overtime has been worked. Provided that this subclause shall not apply to cases where, after application to the Society has been made, extra labour is not forthwith available.

No worker shall be required or permitted to work more than 24 hours overtime in any one week, except in cases of breakdowns in factories or breakdowns on State ships, or in the Minister's plant.

(c) For all work done on Sunday, New Year's Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Labour Day, Christmas Day, or Boxing Day, double time rates shall be paid.

(d) When an employee is recalled to work after leaving the job, he shall be paid at least two hours' overtime for such call-out.

(e) When an employee is required for overtime, after 6 p.m. on week days or after 1 p.m. on Saturdays, without being notified the previous day, he shall be supplied with any meal required, or be paid 1s. 6d. for such meal. This subclause shall not apply to workers residing within a radius of one-half mile of the works.

(f) When an employee is required for duty during any meal time he shall be paid at overtime rate until he be allowed the usual length of time for a meal.

(g) Twelve paid holidays per annum shall be granted to each employee: Provided always, that Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, and Labour Day shall be taken as they come as portion of the holidays. The balance of six days shall be granted as annual leave, at the convenience of the department. Payment for holidays shall be made in accordance with the usual hours of work.

(h) All employees employed for a period of less than 12 months' continuous service shall receive holiday pay as follows:—After one month's continuous service, holidays in proportion as the length of service is to the full number of holidays for the 12 months.

(i) Holiday pay shall be at the rate the worker is in receipt of at or immediately prior to the holiday being taken.

## 3.—Dirt Money.

Employees engaged on dirty work shall be paid 1½d. per hour extra as dirt money. Present practice as to what is dirty work to continue.

## 4.—Wages.

Basic wage—£4 5s. 0d. a week.

Wages paid to workers other than registered apprentices shall be:—

(a) The rate of pay is fixed on a weekly basis, subject to the following condition, namely: That is, in the case of any employee, for any reason whatever during any portion of the working hours of any week no work is available or performed, the employee will only be paid for the time actually worked at the rate of pay as above prescribed (per week of 44 hours) apportioned to the time actually worked during the week; and

(b) That notwithstanding the rate of pay is fixed on a weekly basis, there shall be no obligation on the part of the Minister or the employees to give a week's or any other notice to determine the employment, the position being in this respect the same as if the employee were employed at an hourly wage.

(c) Paragraphs (a) and (b) are in conformity with existing practice, which will continue and be observed.

(d) Payment of wages—When an employee is discharged before the usual pay day he shall be paid his wages when he ceases work, or shall be forwarded to his address the day after by registered post, at the Minister's risk.

## 5.—Apprentices.

(a) In this Agreement a "duly registered apprentice" means an apprentice of whose apprenticeship notice has been given to the Clerk of the Court in accordance with the provisions of this clause, and a "duly registered probationer" means a person working as an apprentice on probation, of whose probationary period notice has been given to the Clerk of the Court in accordance with the provisions of this clause: Provided that an apprentice or probationer shall be deemed to be duly registered during the period of 14 days allowed for registration.

(b) The Minister shall, on taking an apprentice or probationer, within 14 days thereafter, register such apprentice or probationer by giving notice thereof to the Clerk of the Court in Form 1 of the Appendix.

(c) If at any date of this Agreement the Minister is employing any person as an apprentice or probationer who has not been duly registered as such he shall register such apprentice or probationer within fourteen days thereafter.

(d) The maximum number of apprentices allowed the Minister shall be in the proportion of one to every three tradesmen employed: Provided that the Minister shall not be entitled to have apprentices of the same year of their apprenticeship in a greater proportion than one to every four, or fraction of four, tradesmen employed by him: Provided that the fraction of two or four shall not be less than one: Provided also that this Agreement shall not operate to render unlawful or to vary the terms or provisions of any apprenticeship legally existing at the date of its commencement.

(e) For the purpose of ascertaining the number of apprentices allowed to be taken at any time, the average number of journeymen employed on all working days of the six months immediately preceding such time shall be deemed to be the number of journeymen employed.

(f) The term of apprenticeship shall be five years. A probationary period of three months before being bound shall be lawful, such probationary period to be deemed part of the term of apprenticeship.

(g) Should the Minister from unforeseen circumstances be unable to carry out his obligations to his apprentice he shall be allowed to transfer the apprentice to complete his term with another employer, but it shall be incumbent on the Minister to notify the Clerk of the Court of the date of such transfer, and when such apprenticeship commenced, in Form 2 of the Appendix.

(h) The following provisions shall apply in respect to all apprenticeships:—

(1) The Minister shall be deemed to undertake the duty which he agrees to perform as a duty enforceable under this Agreement, and shall, subject to the provisions of Subclause (n), pay the apprentice the rate of wages herein provided.

- (2) At the end of the period of apprenticeship, the Minister shall give the apprentice a certificate to show that he has served his apprenticeship, in Form 5 of the Appendix. Should the Minister at any time before the termination of the period or apprenticeship desire to dispense with the services of the apprentice he may, with the consent of the apprentice, transfer him to another employer carrying on business within a reasonable distance of the Minister's place of business willing to continue to teach the apprentice, and to pay the rate of wages prescribed by the Agreement, according to the total length of time served, and generally to perform the obligations of the Minister. He shall also give to the apprentice a certificate of the time served and of the rate of wages paid, and shall give notice to the Clerk of the Court of such transfer in Form 2 of the Appendix. It shall not be obligatory upon the Minister to find the apprentice another employer if he shall so misconduct himself as to entitle the Minister to discharge him, but he shall nevertheless give him a certificate for the time actually served.
- (3) The Minister shall be deemed to have failed in his duty towards his apprentice if he fails to keep him constantly at work, but slackness of work may form a proper ground for transferring him to a master willing to take the responsibility of teaching him.
- (4) When an apprentice is discharged for cause, the Minister shall send notice in writing of the discharge, and the cause thereof, to the said Clerk of the Court, in Form 3 of the Appendix.
- (i) The minimum wage payable to an apprentice shall be:—

The wages of an apprentice engaged under the terms of this Agreement shall be subject to alteration: Provided that no such alteration shall be made, except when the wages of tradesmen under this Agreement are being reviewed.

(j) Every apprentice shall be bound to submit himself to examination by a Board of Examiners, hereinafter constituted, once in each year of his service when called upon by the Clerk of the Court so to do.

Every apprentice shall, prior to submitting himself to examination, produce to the examiners a certificate that he has made at least 70 per centum of attendances at the Technical School or other place of instruction, unless he is exempted by the Minister from such attendance.

(k) The Clerk of the Court shall notify the Board of Examiners of the names and addresses of apprentices required to submit themselves for examination. The examination shall be held at the place where the apprentice is employed, and it shall be the duty of the Minister to provide such necessary material and machinery as may be required, and in all ways to facilitate the conduct of the examination.

(l) The examination will be held in the month of May each year. The Board of Examiners shall consist of persons skilled in the trade, to be nominated by the Association and by the employers carrying on business within the area to which the Agreement applies, or failing such nomination or nominations, such person or persons as may be appointed by the Court. In the event of a disagreement between the examiners, the matter in dispute shall be referred to a third person agreed to by them or nominated by the Court of by the President at the request of either member, and the decision of such third person shall be final and conclusive. The examiners shall examine the work and inquire into the diligence of each apprentice and as to the opportunities provided by the Minister to each apprentice to learn.

(m) The examiners shall report to the Court in writing as to the result of the examination.

(n) The Clerk of the Court shall supply to each candidate a certificate showing the result of his examination, in Form 4 of the Appendix, and it shall be lawful

for the Minister to withhold the increase in wages accruing in accordance with the scale set forth in Sub-clause (i) hereof from any apprentice who fails to satisfy the examiners.

(o) If the examiners report to the Court that the Minister has not provided sufficient opportunity for the apprentice to learn, the Minister shall be deemed *prima facie* guilty of a breach of this Agreement under Section 90 of the Act, and may be summoned before the Court. Upon any such proceedings, the report may be received in evidence.

(p) Such fees shall be paid by the Clerk to the examiners as the Court shall allow.

6.—Country Work.

(a) When an employee is instructed to proceed on duty from the place where he is then or is usually employed, the Minister shall pay all fares, including sleeper, and a proper allowance at current rates for all necessary meals, or board and lodging. Fares shall be second class, except when travelling by coastal boat, when saloon fares shall be paid, and shall include return fare on completion of job or after twelve months on job.

(b) Travelling time shall be paid at ordinary rates at place of departure, with a maximum of a day's pay when travelling by boat or in a sleeper. When travelling by night without a sleeper the worker shall be entitled to receive an extra day's pay for such travelling. No time to be lost through travelling.

7.—Under-rate Workers.

Any worker who, by reason of old age or infirmity is unable to earn the minimum wage, may be paid such lesser wage as may from time to time be agreed in writing between the Minister and the Association.

8.—Term of Agreement.

The currency of this Agreement shall be three years from the date hereof: Provided that at any time after the expiration of twelve months from its date the Court may alter or amend the Agreement, on the application of any party or person affected by its provisions.

9.—Right of Entry to Works.

On notifying the Officer in Charge, any officer of the Union authorised in writing by the President and Secretary of such Union, shall have the right to enter any place or premises during ordinary working hours wherein members of such Union covered by this Agreement are engaged, for the purpose of conversing with or interviewing the employees in such place or premises: Provided that such officer shall not hamper or otherwise hinder the employees in the carrying out of their work. The officer in charge shall determine whether employees are being hampered or hindered in their work.

10.—Shop Stewards.

Subject to the recognition of properly constituted authority, shop stewards to be appointed by the Union shall be recognised by the management.

11.—Higher Duties.

Any employee called upon to perform work carrying a higher minimum than his regular rate of pay, shall be paid such higher minimum for the time actually engaged upon such higher work: Provided that acting time less than twenty minutes in any one shift shall not be counted.

12.—Broken Shifts.

Should any employee not be notified before leaving work that his services will not be required on the next day, he shall be paid for that day if he duly presents himself for work at the appointed time; unless he cannot be employed, on account of causes beyond the control of the management, in which case he shall be notified forthwith of the cause why he cannot be employed, and shall be entitled to two hours' pay.

13.—Notice Boards.

A notice board shall be provided by the employer on all jobs where in the opinion of the officer in charge it is considered that notices are essential to meet the convenience of the Union concerned.

14.—Area.

This Agreement shall apply to the State Implement and Engineering Works at North Fremantle,
