WHEREAS by "The Rights in Water and Irrigation Act, 1914," it is provided that the Governor may, on the recommendation of the Minister, acting with the advice of the Commissioners appointed under the said Act, by Order in Council extend any Irrigation District:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Administrator, by and with the advice of the Executive Council on the recommendation of the Minister acting with the advice of the said Commissioners, doth hereby extend the Waroona Irrigation District by adding thereto the land described in the Schedule hereto.

NOTICE is hereby given that the following Stay Orders have been issued in accordance with Section 7 Subsection 1 of the Farmers' Debts Adjustment Act, 1930, and Amendment Act, 1931, which reads as follows:—
