AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chambers, at Perth, on the 28th day of June, 1932, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

Public Works Act, 1902.

Sale of Land at Georgina resumed for Geraldton-Walkaway Railway.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W. 146/32; Ex. Co. No. 1091.

WHEREAS by Section 29 of "The Public Works Act, 1902," it is made lawful for the Governor to cause to be sold by private contract any land taken for a public work but no longer required for such public work: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Administrator, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the power conferred by the recited section aforesaid, doth hereby authorise the sale by private contract of portion of Victoria Location 415, being the land at Georgina coloured green on Plan P.W.D., W.A., 27056 (L.T.O. Diagram 9191), such land not being now required for the purposes for which it was resumed, namely, Geraldton-Walkaway Railway.

Forests Act, 1918.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

F.D. 1732/31.

WHEREAS by "The Forests Act, 1918," it is provided that a dedication under the said Act of Crown land as a State Forest may be revoked in whole or in part in the following manner: (a) the Governor shall cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament a proposal for such revocation; (b) after such proposal has been laid before Parliament, the Governor, on a resolution being passed by both Houses that such proposal be carried out, shall by Order in Council re-

voke such dedication: And whereas His Excellency the Administrator did cause to be laid on the Table of each House of Parliament his proposal dated the Seventeenth day of November, 1931, for the revocation in part of the dedication of Crown lands as State Forest: And whereas after such proposal had been laid before Parliament a resolution was passed by both Houses that such proposal should be carried out: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Administrator, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby revoke in part the dedication of Crown lands as State Forest No. 37 by excising that portion of such State Forest as is described in the Schedule hereto:—

Land Drainage Act, 1925.  
Harvey No. 2 Drainage District.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 625/32.

WHEREAS by Section 11 of "The Land Drainage Act, 1925," the Governor may constitute any defined portion of the State a Drainage District, specify the boundaries of such District, assign a name to such District: Now therefore, His Excellency the Administrator, with the advice of the Executive Council, doth hereby constitute a Drainage District, having the boundaries described in the Schedule hereto, and assign the name of the Harvey No. 2 Drainage District thereto:—

Commencing at a point on the Perth-Bunbury Road opposite the North-Eastern corner of Lot 32 of Wellington Location 50, near Wokalup Bridge, and proceeding in a South-Westerly direction along the Eastern boundary of said road, to and across the South-Western Railway Reserve; thence continuing in a Southerly direction along the said Eastern boundary of the Perth-Bunbury Road to a point opposite the South-East corner of Lot 35 of Location 1; thence across said road and continuing West along the South boundaries of Lots 35, 34, 33, 32, 31 and Road No. 3030 to the Eastern boundary of said road; thence in a generally Southerly and Westerly direction along the Eastern boundary of said road to post marked Z17; thence South-Westerly in a straight line to the junction of the Mornington and Wellesley Rivers; thence Westerly across said Wellesley River to its right bank and North-Westerly in a straight line to a point on the Eastern boundary of Wellington Road, opposite the South boundary of Mysore Road; thence continuing in said direction across Wellington Road to its Western boundary; thence in a North-Easterly direction along the Western boundary of said road to and across Road No. 3030; thence North-Westerly, continuing along said Western boundary of Wellington Road, across Marlborough Road to the South-East corner of Rural Lot 54 of Wellington Road, part of Wellington Location 1; thence West along South boundary of said Lot 54 and the South boundaries of Rural Lots 11, 9, and 7 of Douro Road to the South-West corner of said Lot 7; thence North along the West boundary of said Lot 7, across Douro Road and along the West boundaries of Rural Lot 8 of Douro Road and Rural Lot 7 of Myerlup Road to the South boundary of Myerlup Road; thence North across said road and Northerly in a straight line to the South-West corner of Wellington Location 1153; thence continuing North along the West boundary of said location, across Road No. 171 and North along West boundary of Location 1105 to its North-West corner; thence Northerly in a straight line through State Forest No. 16 and across Road No. 102 to the South-West corner of Location 2166; thence North along the West boundary of said location and the West and North boundaries of Location 2167 to the South-East corner of Location 3028; thence North along the East boundary and West along the North boundary of said location to the South-East corner of Location 3029; thence North along the East boundary of said location to the Southern boundary of Crampton Road; thence North-Westerly along the said Southern boundary to the 2 Mile Post; thence North, via straight line across Crampton Road and Location 2427 to the North boundary of said location; thence East along the North boundaries of Locations 2427 and 2684 and the South boundary of Location 1021 to and across Richardson Road; thence North along the East boundary of said Road to the North-West corner of Uduc Agricultural Area Lot 33; thence East along the North boundaries of Lots 33, 34 and 35, across Gibbs Road, and along the North boundaries of Lots 36 and 37 to Jackson Road; thence South-Easterly along the Western boundary of said road to a point opposite the North boundary of Wellington Location 3164; thence East across Jackson Road and along the North boundary of said location to its North-East corner; thence North across Harvey Main Drain Reserve and along the West boundary of Harvey Agricultural Area Lot 179 to Thomson Road; thence East along the South side of Thomson Road; across Harvey Road and continuing along Thomson Road, across Road No. 1014 to the Western boundary of the South-Western Railway Reserve; thence Southerly along said boundary to the Northern boundary of Korijekup Estate; thence in a generally Westerly, Southerly,

South-Westerly, Easterly, Southerly and Easterly direction along the boundary of the existing Harvey Drainage District as redefined in *Government Gazette* on 9th December, 1921, and as shown margined in green on Plan P.W.D., W.A., 27103, to the point of commencement, as indicated in red on Plan P.W.D., W.A., 27103.

## FARMERS' DEBTS ADJUSTMENT ACT, 1930.

NOTICE is hereby given that the following Stay Orders have been issued in accordance with Section 7, Subsection 1, of "The Farmers' Debts Adjustment Act, 1930," and Amendment Act, 1931, which reads as follows:—

A Stay Order shall direct that no action, execution, distress for rent, proceedings on default or breach of covenant under any mortgage or other security for money, or under an agreement of sale and purchase of land, or other process or proceeding, shall be commenced or proceeded with or put in force against the farmer or his estate or effects during the operation of such Stay Order. Provided that by leave of a judge any action may, notwithstanding the Stay Order, be instituted and/or carried on against the farmer, but not beyond judgment.

Regulation 63 is amended to read as follows:—

No mallet tree under ten inches in circumference, measured over the bark at three feet from the ground or any lesser height shall be felled by virtue of a license or permit or by virtue of an order issued under the authority of a license, unless expressly provided therein.

Regulation 64 is amended to read as follows:—

Every person employed in the stripping of mallet bark under a license shall strip all limbs of a diameter of not less than two inches, as well as the boles of all mallet trees felled by him.
