## Parliament Summoned to Meet for Business. PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, | By His Excellency Sir John Alfred TO WIT. | Northmore, K.C.M.G., Administrator in J. A. NORTHMORE, and over the State of Western Aus-Milia and its Dependencies in the [L.S.] Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS under the provisions of "The Constitution Act, 1889," it is made lawful for the Governor of Western Australia to fix the time and place for the holding of the first and every other session of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly: Now, therefore I, the Administrator, do hereby further prorogue the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly until the eleventh day of August next, and, in exercise of the said power so vested in me, do by this my Proclamation announce and proclaim that the Second Session

of the Fourteenth Parliament of Western Australia shall be holden for the dispatch of business on Thursday, the 11th day of August, 1932, at the hour of 12 o'clock noon, in the House of Parliament in the City of Perth; and Members of the Legislative Council and Members of the Legislative Assembly are hereby required to give their attendance at the said time and place accordingly.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this twentieth day of July, 1932.
