## PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, } By His Excellency Sir John Alfred  
TO WIT. } Northmore, K.C.M.G., Lieutenant-Gov-

WHEREAS by "The Constitution Act, 1889," it is provided that it shall be lawful for the Governor to prorogue the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly from time to time by Proclamation or otherwise, whenever he shall think fit: Now, therefore I, the said Lieut.-Governor and Administrator, in exercise of the

power conferred by the said Act, do hereby prorogue the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly until Tuesday, the seventh day of February, 1933.
