AGRICULTURAL BANK ACT, 1906-1930.

Executive Council Chamber,
Perth, 21st April, 1933.

HIS Excellency the Lieut.-Governor in Executive Council has been pleased to repeal the Regulations made under "The Agricultural Bank Act, 1906-1930," and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 4th November, 1932, and, under the provisions of Section 34B of the said Act, as reprinted in the Sessional Volume of the Statutes for the year, 1930, to make, in lieu of the said Regulations, new Regulations as follows:—

Regulations.

3. The rate of interest to be charged by the Agricultural Bank on all advances heretofore or hereafter made under the provisions of "The Agricultural Bank Act, 1906-1930," for any purpose, including the effecting of improvements, shall not exceed five per centum per annum.

4. The rate of interest prescribed by the preceding regulation shall have effect as from the first day of January, 1933.

1.
