Kununoppin-Trayning Road Board.

By-law re Stationary Motor Vehicles. P.W. 916/22.

THE Kununoppin-Trayning Road Board, pursuant to an Order in Council under Section 43 of "The Traffic Act, 1919-31," and in exercise of the power thereby conferred, doth hereby make the following By-law to regulate the standing of vehicles in Townsites within the Kununoppin-Trayning Road District:—

The person in charge of any motor-vehicle shall at all times, when leaving such vehicle stationary in any street of any Township situated within the Kununoppin-Trayning Road District, stop with the left-hand or "near" side front wheel drawn in as close as practicable to the kerbing or footpath, with the left or "near" side of the vehicle placed at an angle of 45 degrees with the kerbing or footpath alignment.

THE ROAD DISTRICTS ACT, 1919-32. By-laws of the Greenmount Road Board.

P.W. 1214/22.

WHEREAS by "The Road Districts Act, 1919-1932," the Road Board of any District is empowered under Section 196 of the said Act to make By-laws for regulating and controlling, quarrying, and blasting operations, and under Section 196a to make By-laws to regulate or prohibit quarrying for stone, gravel, or other material within townsites and prescribed areas without the license of the Board: The Greenmount Road Board, in pursuance of the powers vested in the said Board, under and by virtue of the said Act and every other authority enabling it in that behalf, doth hereby make and publish the following By-laws:—

1. No person shall, within the Townsite of Darlington, nor within the following Prescribed Area of Greenmount, namely:—

That area having for its Southern boundary the Northern boundary of Helena Location 20b; thence North along the East boundary of Swan Location 16; thence East along Greenmount lots to Ferguson Road; thence North along the West boundary of National Park to the North-East corner of Swan Location 1160; thence West along the North boundary of Swan Location 1160 to the North-West corner of Swan Location 1160; thence South along Viveash Road to Morrison Road; thence West along Morrison Road to Balfour Road, along Balfour Road due South to York road; thence East along York Road to Stewart Street, along Stewart Street due South to starting point

- 2. Any person who has obtained such license as aforesaid shall, before commencing or suffering or permitting blasting or quarrying operations, put up such notices, to the approval of the secretary of the said Board, and in such places as may be directed by such permission, or by the said secretary, and shall keep such notices conspicuously exhibited during the time such blasting or quarrying operations are being carried out.
- 3. The secretary of the said Board may give such directions (if any) as he deems advisable with respect to the size, weight, or amount of any explosive that may be used in any one charge in blasting operations.
- 4. The secretary of the said Board may in his discretion order any place, where blasting or quarrying operations are being carried on, to be fenced in such manner as he may deem advisable for the protection of persons, stock, or property.
- 5. Notwithstanding the granting of such license as aforesaid, the said Board may order any blasting or quarrying operations to be discontinued, either forthwith or at a time to be specified in such order.
- 6. Any person who has obtained such permission shall observe all reasonable and proper precautious for preventing accident to persons, stock, or property during blasting operations, and, not more than ten minutes nor less than five minutes prior to any charge being fixed, shall sound in a proper and audible manner a bell or other device, to be approved of by the secretary of the said Board, to warn all persons residing in the vicinity of the place where such charge is about to be fixed.
- 7. No person shall be exempted from liability for any damage occasioned to any person, stock, or property arising from any blasting or quarrying operations by reason only of having obtained such permission as aforesaid, or of having complied with all orders or directions of the secretary of the said Board.
- 8. In the event of any damage being caused to any footpath, street, roadway, or other property belonging to or under the control of the said Board by any such blasting or quarrying operations, such damage shall forthwith be repaired and made good to the satisfaction of the secretary of the said Board and, in default of the person by whom or under whose authority such blasting or quarrying operations have been carried on failing to do so when required by the secretary of the said Board, the necessary work may be done by the Board under the supervision of its officers employed in that behalf, and the cost of such reparation and making good shall forthwith be repaid to the said Board by the person by whom or under whose authority such blasting or quarrying operations have been carried on.
- 9. Any person who, without permission in writing from the secretary of the said Board, shall carry on any blasting or quarrying operations, or permit or suffer the same to be carried on, or who shall neglect to observe and carry out the orders of the said Board, or of the secretary of the said Board, or who offends against any of the provisions of this By-law, shall on conviction forfeit and pay for every such offence a sum not exceeding £20.
