IT is hereby notified, for public information, that His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor in Executive Council has been pleased, pursuant to Section 5 of "The Agricultural Bank Act, 1934," (1)—to appoint Alexander McCallum, of South Fremantle, formerly Member of the Legislative Assembly, and Charles Lionel Clarke, of Waterloo, Farmer, to be members of the Commissioners of the Agricultural Bank of Western Australia, to hold office for the term of seven years from the 18th day of March, 1935, and to appoint the said Alexander McCallum to be Chairman of the Commissioners of the Agricultural Bank of Western Australia; (2)—to fix the salary of the said Alexander McCallum at the sum of Two Thousand Pounds per annum and the salary of the said Charles Lionel Clarke at the sum of One Thousand Five hundred Pounds per annum.
