FARMERS' DEBTS ADJUSTMENT ACT, 1930-1934.

NOTICE is hereby given that the following Stay Orders have been issued in accordance with Section 7, Subsection 1, of "The Farmers' Debts Adjustment Act, 1930-1934," which reads as follows:—

A Stay Order shall direct that no action, execution, distress for rent, proceedings on default for breach of covenant under any mortgage or other security for money, or under an agreement for sale and purchase of land, or other process or proceeding, shall be commenced or proceeded with or put in force against the farmer or any of the farmer's assets, whether utilised in connection with or forming portion of the assets comprised in his farming business or not during the operations of such Stay Order: Provided that, by leave of a Judge, any action may, notwithstanding the Stay Order, be instituted and/or carried on against the farmer, but not beyond judgment.

IT is hereby notified, for general information, that the areas scheduled hereunder are available for selection under Part V. of "The Land Act, 1933," and the Regulations appertaining thereto, subject to the provisions of the said Act.

Applications must be lodged at the Local Land Office for the district in which the land is situated, not later than the date specified, but may be lodged before such date if so desired.

All applications lodged on or before such date will be treated as having been received on the closing day, and if there are more applicants than one for any block, the application to be granted will be determined by the Land Board. Should any lands remain unselected such will continue available until applied for or otherwise dealt with.

If a Land Board sitting becomes necessary, the applicants for the blocks will be duly notified of the date, time and place of the meeting of the Board, and there shall be an interval of at least three days between the closing date and the sitting of the Board.

If an applicant wishes to appear before the Land Board in person he may apply to the Head Office or to the Clerk in Charge of any of the District or Branch Land Offices for a certificate to the Railway Department which, on presentation at the nearest Railway Station, will entitle him to a Return Ticket, at Excursion Rates, to the place where the Board will sit, available for seven days from the date of issue.

This Agreement, made in pursuance of "The Industrial Arbitration Act, 1912-1925," the 4th day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five, between the Western Australia Musicians' Industrial Union of Workers, Perth (hereinafter called "the Union"), of the one part, and the Entrepreneurs' Association Industrial Union of Employers of Western Australia (hereinafter called "the Employers"), of the other part, witnesseth:—

Whereas an Industrial Agreement, Numbered 11 of 1928, was made on the 28th day of March, 1928, between the Union and the employers and registered at the Court of Arbitration of Western Australia; Now it is hereby agreed by and between the parties hereto that the said Industrial Agreement be and the same is hereby amended by the addition of the following new Clause 4A:—

"Temporary provisions as to playing an extra instrument, rehearsals, and switching over, or transferring an orchestra to more than one picture show:

(i) Notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained, the following special provisions shall apply for the period commencing 4th March, 1935, and ending 4th June, 1935.

(a) Playing an extra Instrument: Any musician may double or play an extra instrument during any night performance in a picture show, and the employer shall not be required to pay extra for playing an extra instrument, and Clause (f) of Industrial Agreement No. 11 of 1928, relating to playing an extra instrument, shall be suspended during the currency of and the continuance of these temporary provisions.

- (b) Special provisions as to Rehearsals: Sub-clause (b) (4) of Clause B and Sub-clauses (h) (i), (h) (ii), (h) (iii), (h) (iv), (h) (v) of Clause G of Industrial Agreement, No. 11 of 1928, are varied as follows:—

The whole of the provisions relating to rehearsals and payment for same shall be suspended during the currency of and the continuance of these temporary provisions, and arrangements may be made between the employer and the orchestra for rehearsals between the hours of 9 o'clock a.m. and 11 o'clock a.m., on not more than three mornings in any one week, and such rehearsals shall be free.

- (c) Further, it shall be permissible for an employer, carrying on business in more than one picture show to transfer, or switch over the whole of his orchestra to a second picture theatre, under his direct control and management, during any part of the time occupied for an evening performance, which shall not exceed three and one quarter hours for both, and the employer shall not be permitted to transfer or switch over his band or orchestra to more than two of his picture theatres under his direct control and management during any evening session or performance.
- (ii) The foregoing provisions may be continued from month to month after the said 4th June, 1935, by agreement between the parties, a memorandum of which, signed by or on behalf of the parties, shall be filed in the Court. In the event of the parties failing to agree, the matter may be referred to the Court.
- (iii) The provisions of this amendment shall not affect or prejudice the right of any of the parties to the said Industrial Agreement to apply to the Court for a further amendment thereof in pursuance of Section 90 of "The Industrial Arbitration Act, 1912-1925," or for a new Award, should the occasion arise.
- (iv) Save as is herein expressly provided, and for the term or terms herein expressed or provided for, the said industrial Agreement shall remain in full force and effect."
