FARMERS' DEBTS ADJUSTMENT ACT, 1930-1934.

NOTICE is hereby given that the following Stay Orders have been issued in accordance with Section 7, Sub-section 1, of "The Farmers' Debts Adjustment Act, 1930-1934," which reads as follows:—

A Stay Order shall direct that no action, execution, distress for rent, proceedings on default for breach of covenant under any mortgage or other security for money, or under an agreement for sale and purchase of land, or other process or proceeding, shall be commenced or proceeded with or put in force against the farmer or any of the farmer's assets, whether utilised in connection with or forming portion of the assets comprised in his farming business or not during the operation of such Stay Order: Provided that, by leave of a Judge, any action may, notwithstanding the Stay Order, be instituted and/or carried on against the farmer, but not beyond judgment.

THE AGRICULTURAL BANK ACT, 1934.

Regulations.

1. These Regulations may be cited as "The Agricultural Bank Regulations, 1935," and are divided into Parts, as follows:—

Part I.—The Commissioners—Meetings—Management and Conduct of Business—Common Seal, etc.

Part II.—Applications for Advances—Valuations and Inspections.

Part III.—Form of Security.

Part IV.—Procedure at Inquiries.

Part V.—Offences.

Part I.

2. The Commissioners shall meet together for the transaction of business as often as may be necessary, and shall keep minutes of their proceedings in a minute book.

3. At every meeting of the Commissioners the business of the meeting shall be the reading of the minutes of the proceedings at the preceding meeting and the putting of a question for the confirmation of the minutes of that meeting. No discussion shall be permitted thereon, except as to their accuracy as a record of the proceedings; after confirmation the minutes of proceedings at the preceding meeting shall then be signed by the Chairman.

4. After the confirmation and the signing of the minutes of the preceding meeting, consideration shall be given to the business of the meeting, in such order as the Commissioners may decide.

5. The Chairman, when called upon to decide on points of order or practice, shall state which he deems applicable to the case without discussing or commenting on the same; his decision as to order or explanation in each case shall be final.

6. Any member of the Commissioners may at any time demand the production of any of the documents of the Commissioners applying to the question under discussion, and may at any time during business hours have access to all the records and documents of the Commissioners.

7. At every meeting of the Commissioners all motions, whether original motions or amendments shall, if required by the Chairman, be—

- (a) reduced into writing;
- (b) signed by the mover; and
- (c) delivered to the Chairman immediately on their being moved and seconded.

Common Seal.

8. The Commissioners shall keep a Common Seal, bearing the name of the Commissioners and containing some appropriate device thereon.

9. The Common Seal shall be kept in safe custody by the Secretary, or some authorised officer, at the office of the Commissioners, in Perth, and shall not in any circumstances be affixed to any document except—

- (a) pursuant to a resolution passed at a meeting of the Commissioners; and
- (b) by the Secretary, or some other authorised officer, in the presence of at least one member of the Commissioners, and the Secretary or such authorised officer shall attest the affixing of the seal.

Hours of Business.

10. The office of the Commissioners shall be open for business as follows:—
10 o'clock a.m. to 3 o'clock p.m., from Monday to Friday inclusive; and from 10 o'clock to 12 o'clock noon on Saturdays, except public holidays.

Receipts and Disbursements.

11. (a) No money shall be received on account of the Commissioners by any person or persons whomsoever other than such of the officers or agents of the Commissioners as are authorised to receive such moneys.

(b) Every receipt issued by an authorised officer shall be on an official form, to be supplied by the Commissioners.

12. Any receipt given for any such moneys received by any person other than the authorised officer of the Commissioners shall be null and void.

13. All moneys paid to the Commissioners shall be paid at the office of the Commissioners, or at some District Office of the Commissioners, or to some person authorised to receive money on behalf of the Commissioners.

14. All such moneys shall be paid to the credit of the special account to be kept at the Treasury in the name of the Commissioners, pursuant to the Act, as soon as practicable after the receipt thereof by the officer authorised by the Commissioners to receive such moneys.

15. No withdrawals shall be made from the said account other than on account of payments which have been authorised by the Commissioners, or on account of payments which are made by persons authorised by the Commissioners to make the same.

16. All cheques drawn against the said account shall be signed by some person authorised in that behalf by the Commissioners.

Control of Securities.

17. All securities shall be under the direct control of some person authorised by the Commissioners and who shall be responsible for the safe custody thereof.

18. In order to keep a proper check on the securities of the Commissioners, such authorised person shall keep a register of securities and enter therein from time to time all securities on which the Commissioners have advanced any moneys, and make a note of the disposition thereof from time to time.

19. No security or title shall be produced at the request of any subsequent encumbrancer, transferee, or other person interested in obtaining production, except on payment of such fee or fees as the Commissioners may deem reasonable in the circumstances.

20. The authorised person in control of the securities shall be responsible for making available to the audit officer of the Auditor General the securities of the Commissioners for audit purposes.

21. No security shall be discharged until the whole of the moneys secured by the security, together with the customary closing fee, are first paid.

Part II.

Applications for Advances.

22. All applications for advances shall be in the form Numbered 1 in the Schedule.

23. (a) All applications shall be accompanied by a fee of one per cent. of the amount applied for to cover the inspection and valuation.

(b) Such fee shall be retained by the Commissioners, whether the required advance or any part thereof is made or not, unless the Commissioners in their discretion otherwise direct.

24. The applicant shall, when required, attend personally at the office of the Commissioners or elsewhere, as may be appointed, and, if necessary, truthfully answer on oath all such questions as the Commissioners may ask him, and shall, if so required, answer such questions in writing.

25. The applicant shall produce to the Commissioners free of charge, all deeds, certificates of title, conditional purchase leases and other documents relating to the securities offered, as the Commissioners may require.

26. The applicant shall pay all charges and outlays in connection with the investigation of his title and perfecting and registering of his securities.

27. The Commissioners may direct advances to be made by instalments, as the work proceeds, or in one sum.

28. (a) Should an application be accepted either wholly or in part, and the applicant fail to produce his securities for registration within two months from the date of acceptance, such application may be cancelled, and no part of the inspection fee shall be refunded.

(b) Where loans are not drawn on for a period of 12 months, the Commissioners may cancel the unexpended balance.

29. Every applicant for an advance shall set out a full statement of his assets and liabilities, distinguishing between those liabilities which are secured and those which are unsecured and, in the former case, shall give particulars of the securities held by his several creditors.

Valuations and Inspections.

30. Every inspector or other person employed by the Commissioners to make a valuation of any property shall, subject to any specific instructions which may be given to him—

- (a) describe the situation, locality, soil, water supply, means of access, and any other circumstances affecting the value of the land as a security;
- (b) give a detailed list and valuation of all improvements, stating the time when such improvements were effected and their general condition;
- (c) give his valuation of the unimproved value of the land and of the entire property;

- (d) give his opinion of the suitability and income-producing nature of the improvements proposed to be made and advanced upon, and their probable cost and value when effected;
 - (e) report upon the character and personal qualification of the applicant for the advance.
31. It shall be the duty of an inspector—
- (a) to inspect from time to time the improvements which are in the course of being effected by means of advances from the Commissioners;
 - (b) report upon the amount of instalments of the advance which can be fairly paid on the progress of such improvements;
 - (c) to report upon the manner in which the advance has been applied and, particularly, in the event of any money not having been applied for the purpose for which it was advanced, or having been expended in a careless or extravagant manner, to report to the Commissioners as to the circumstances thereof;
 - (d) to report from time to time upon the general condition and state of repair of the land and improvements thereon upon which advances have been made by the Commissioners;
 - (e) to render prompt assistance to *bona fide* applicants in the preparation of applications for advances.
32. All reports by valuers and inspectors shall be addressed to the Branch Manager concerned who, after causing the same to be examined, shall forward them to the General Manager.

Part III.

Form of Security.

33. No forms of security other than those which are according to the forms approved by the Commissioners for general use shall be used in the conduct of the business of the Commissioners.

34. Should any material alteration of these forms become necessary to suit the circumstances of any particular case, the responsible officer of the staff concerned will, where necessary, obtain the opinion of the Crown Solicitor in regard to the particular security.

Part IV.

Procedure at Inquiries.

35. At all inquiries held by the Commissioners under the provisions of Section 6 of the Act, the form of procedure shall be as nearly as may be to that which pertains to the holding of Royal Commissions.

36. The statement of any person who gives evidence before the Commissioners shall be reduced to writing, and shall be read over to him and then signed by him.

37. Any person who gives any false testimony at any inquiry by the Commissioners shall be guilty of an offence against these Regulations.

38. Any oath or affirmation necessary to be administered to any person at an inquiry, may be administered by an authorised officer of the Commissioners in the presence of the Commissioners.

39. The Commissioners may require the attendance of any person, or the production of any document by any person, and for that purpose may issue a summons to witness, or summons to produce the said document or documents, and shall exercise in that regard the like powers and authorities as Justices may exercise in Petty Sessions.

40. Any person who—

- (a) fails to attend and give evidence before the Commissioners; or
- (b) having attended to give evidence as a witness, refuses to answer any question put to him, or is guilty of any contumacious behaviour in the presence of the Commissioners; or
- (c) interrupts any inquiry of the Commissioners,

commits an offence.

41. If any person fails to appear before the Commissioners in response to any summons to witness, or to any summons to produce documents issued to him by the Commissioners, the Commissioners may issue a warrant under their hands, which shall authorise any police constable to arrest such witness and bring him before them.

Part V.

Offences.

42. (1) Every person who by act or omission commits a breach of these Regulations commits an offence.

Penalty: Twenty pounds.

(2) Notwithstanding any conviction under these Regulations the Commissioners shall not be prejudiced in the exercise of the disciplinary powers of the Commissioners against any member of the staff.
