PUBLIC SERVICE RECLASSIFICATION

(To date from 1st January, 1936.)

SECOND AND FINAL SECTION.

1. This second and final section of the Public Service Reclassification, embracing the following Divisions:—

Second Section Clerical,
Professional,
General,
Administrative,

is published under Section 12 of the Public Service Appeal Board Act, 1920, as the final part of the general reclassification of the Service, to date from the 1st January, 1936.

2. The provision made in the first section of the Reclassification, under the heading of "Basic Wage," shall have equal application to this section, subject to the following proviso:—

- (a) Adjustment shall not apply to the salaries of officers whose maximum salary under this classification is over £699.
- (b) The adjustment in respect of the salary of female officers whose actual salary exceeds £210 per annum shall be at the rate of 80 per cent. to the nearest pound of any adjustment applicable to the adult male minimum rate of £185 per annum, except in any special case in which the Commissioner approves of the male adjustment operating.

3. The Treasury memorandum printed as an appendix to the first section shall be read as one with this section, subject to the proviso set out in paragraph 2 herein.

4. Officers whose salary is in excess of £699 will be subject to adjustments only when the basic wage fluctuation represents in the aggregate, either up or down, an amount of 7s. 8d. per week, when an adjustment of £20 will be made.

5. The Classification against each office shows clearly the minimum and maximum salaries provided therefor. The increments are annual, subject to certificate under Regulation 43, and no officer can proceed beyond the maximum salary until promoted to a position carrying a higher classification.

6. The scale of salaries above the maximum of the automatic range (£270) is as follows:—

8. Under the General Division officers entitled "tracers" are employed. The increments of these officers will be annual, based on years of service and not on age. £

The less important type of drafting work, copying and colouring, is carried out by draftswomen, who are classified in a range of salaries £160 to £200. This class comprises five grades, viz., £160, £170, £180, £190, £200. Appointments to this section are made from female officers employed as tracers, as above. A qualifying examination for promotion to positions of draftswomen will require to be passed, and appointments made as vacancies arise, in order of merit, the age on appointment to be not less than 21 years. The examination will comprise the following subjects:—Dictation, arithmetic, plotting from field and level books, use of planimeter, etc., plan drawing and colouring. Increments will be annual, based on years of service and not on age.

Under the General Division officers entitled "telephonists" are employed. The increments of these officers will be annual, based on years of service and not on age:—
