THE ELECTORAL ACT, 1907 (AS AMENDED).

Legislative Assembly—District of East Perth.

IT is hereby notified, for general information, that I have this day received from His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor a Warrant, under the provisions of Section 66 of the above-mentioned Act, authorising and directing me to proceed forthwith to issue a Writ for the Election of one Member to serve in the Legislative Assembly for the East Perth District:
