WHEREAS it is enacted by the Factories and Shops Act, 1920-1937, that the expression "Public holiday" shall mean certain days therein specified, and any other day declared by Proclamation to be a public holiday for the purpose of the said Act: And whereas it has been ordered that Monday, the 16th day of November, 1942, shall be observed as a public holiday in honour of the birthday of His Most Gracious Majesty King George VI.: Now, therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim and declare that Monday, the 16th day of November, 1942, shall be a public holiday throughout the State for the purposes of the said Act, and shall be observed as a public holiday under every part of the said Act in which the expression occurs.

WHEREAS by the Transfer of Land Act, 1893, Amendment Act, 1896 (60 Vict., No. 22), the Governor is empowered by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*

AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chamber, at Perth, on the 2nd day of November, 1942, the following Order in Council was authorised to be issued:—

Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1941.

### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 10 of the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1941, that it shall be obligatory for every employer to obtain from an incorporated insurance office approved by the Minister a policy of insurance for the full amount of the liability to pay compensation under this Act to all workers employed by him, but that if an employer proves to the satisfaction of the Minister that such employer has established a fund for insurance against such liability and has deposited at the Treasury securities charged with all payments to become due under such liability the Governor may by Order in Council exempt such employer from the operation of the said section: And whereas The Colonial Mutual Life Assurance Society, Limited, of St.

George's terrace, Perth, being an employer within the meaning of the said Act and as such subject to the provisions of section 10 of the said Act, and having duly, in accordance with the said Act and the regulations made thereunder, made application for exemption from the operation of the said section 10, has satisfied the Minister that it has established a fund for insurance against its liability to pay compensation under the said Act to all workers employed by it, and has deposited at the Treasury securities, to wit, £5,000 3¼ % Australian Consolidated Inscribed Stock 15/12/1952-54, charged with all payments to become due under its liability aforesaid: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the said Act, doth hereby exempt the said The Colonial Mutual Life Assurance Society, Limited, from the operation of section 10 of

the Workers' Compensation Act, 1912-1941, for a period of two years commencing on and including the 16th day of October, 1942.
