AT a meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chambers, at Perth, this 10th day of February, 1943, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:—

Water Boards Act, 1904-1941.

### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 765/42; Ex. Co. 189.

WHEREAS by the Water Boards Act, 1904-1941, and the Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1912, the Governor is empowered by Order in Council to constitute the district of a local authority or two or more local authorities, or any part or parts of such district or districts, a water area, under such name as may be directed: And whereas, under the provisions of the said Acts, the Governor may authorise the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage to exercise within a Water Area all the functions of a Water Board: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby constitute an area, having the boundaries described in the Schedule hereunder, a Water Area for the purpose of the said Acts, under the name of the Boyup Brook Water Area, and does hereby appoint the Minister of Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage to exercise all the functions of a Water Board under the Acts in such area.

This Order in Council shall take effect on the 12th day of February, 1943.

### Schedule.

#### Boyup Brook Water Area.

Commencing on the right bank of the Blackwood River at its intersection with the prolongation of the northern side of Barron street; thence following the right bank of the said river in a generally southerly direction, crossing Boyup Brook and continuing to the north-eastern corner of Location 710; thence proceeding westwards along the northern boundary of the said location to its north-western corner; thence in a generally northerly direction along the eastern side of Jayes road,

crossing Barron, Forrest, and Abel streets, and continuing along the said eastern side to its intersection with the prolongation of the north-eastern side of Blechynden street; thence north-westwards along the said prolongation and along the said north-eastern side of Blechynden street to its intersection with the eastern side of Williams street; thence northwards along the eastern side of Williams street and its prolongation, crossing a right-of-way and continuing along the said prolongation to its intersection with the southern boundary of the Katanning-Donnybrook Railway Reserve; thence south-eastwards along the said southern boundary crossing Jayes road and Inglis street, and continuing in a generally eastwards direction along the said boundary to a point due north of the point of commencement; thence southwards to the point of commencement.

Also an area, the north and south boundaries of which are lines 25 links distant on each side of the pipe line survey described hereunder:—That is, commencing on the northern side of Bridge road at a point opposite the western end of the Bridge over the Blackwood river, and proceeding on a bearing of 90deg 3min. for a distance of about 5 chains 50 links; thence on a bearing of 69deg. 41min. for a distance of 19 chains 50 links; thence on a bearing of 81deg. 12min. for a distance of 5 chains 66 links; thence on a bearing of 110deg. 41min. for a distance of 1 mile 3 chains 28 links; thence on a bearing of 101deg. 32min. for a distance of 64 chains 82 links; thence on a bearing of 120deg. 9min. for a distance of about 12 chains; also commencing on the western boundary of Location 6227 at a point 1,390 links south of the north-western corner of the said location and proceeding on a bearing of 78deg. for a distance of about 51 chains; thence on a bearing of 113deg. for about 14 chains intersecting the eastern boundary of Location 6227 at a point 850 links south of the north-eastern corner of the said location; thence on a bearing of 98deg. for about 14 chains, intersecting the western boundary of Location 6430 at a point 1,056 links south of the southern boundary of Location 2900; thence on a bearing of 102deg. for about 14 chains 75 links; thence on a bearing of 116deg. for about 5

chains 27 links; thence on a bearing of 108deg. about 11 chains 3 links; thence on a bearing of 98deg. for about 19 chains; thence on a bearing of 43deg. for about 8 chains; thence on a bearing of 101deg. for about 11 chains; thence on a bearing of 86deg. for about 8 chains 78 links; thence on a bearing of 129deg. for about 8 chains; thence on a bearing of 174deg. for about 10 chains; thence on a bearing of 168deg. for about 18 chains 50 links; thence on a bearing of 209deg. for about 23 chains crossing the southern boundary of Location 6430 at a point about 5,040 links west of the south-eastern corner of Location 6430; thence on a bearing of 188deg. for about 26 chains 50 links; thence on a bearing of 250deg. for about 9 chains 89 links; thence on a bearing of 265deg. for about 10 chains; thence on a bearing of 275deg. for about 23 chains; thence on a bearing of 254deg. for about 16 chains; thence on a bearing of 320deg. for about 11 chains 80 links; thence on a bearing of 267deg. for about 9 chains; thence on a bearing of 280deg. for about 15 chains; thence on a bearing of 296deg. for about 12 chains 60 links; thence on a bearing of 299deg. for about 11 chains 24 links, intersecting the southern boundary of Location 6227 at a point about 2,550 links west of the south-eastern corner of the said location; thence on a bearing of 324deg. for about 8 chains; thence on a bearing of 306deg. for about 5 chains 50 links; thence on a bearing of 301deg. for about 9 chains; thence on a bearing of 12deg. for about 4 chains 30 links; thence on a bearing of 95deg. for about 24 chains 12 links; thence on a bearing of 66deg. for about 4 chains 10 links; thence on a bearing of 101deg. for about 3 chains 78 links; thence on a bearing of 25deg. for about 10 chains; thence on a bearing of 351deg. for about 2 chains 63 links; thence on a bearing of 300deg. for about 2 chains 66 links; thence on a bearing of 269deg. for about 4 chains 73 links; thence on a bearing of 298deg. for about 3 chains 16 links; thence on a bearing of 324deg. for about 3 chains 85 links; thence on a bearing of 277deg. for about 16 chains; thence on a bearing of 332deg. for about 10 chains; thence on a bearing of 243deg. for about 8 chains 34 links; thence on a bearing of 325deg. for about 6 chains; thence on a bearing of 236deg. for about 6 chains 97 links; thence on a bearing of 282deg. for about 4 chains 32 links; thence on a bearing of 248deg. for about 2 chains 24 links; thence on a bearing of 298deg. for about 2 chains 37 links, intersecting the western boundary of Location 6227 at a point 2,690 links south of the north-western corner of the said location; thence northwards along the western boundary of the said Location 6227 to the point of commencement.

Water Reserve and Catchment Area.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

P.W.W.S. 1200/37; Ex. Co. 188.

WHEREAS by section 36 of the Water Boards Act, 1904-1942, the Governor may from time to time by Order in Council constitute any portion of the State a water reserve or catchment area, and define the boundaries thereof, and where such water reserve or catchment area comprises only lands which have not been alienated place such water reserve or catchment area under the temporary management and control of a Water Board: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby constitute the portion of the State defined in the following Schedule a water reserve and catchment area, and place such lands under the temporary management and control of the Manjimup Water Board.

## LAND OPEN FOR SELECTION.

IT is hereby notified, for general information, that the areas scheduled hereunder are available for selection under Part V. of the Land Act, 1933-1939, and the regulations appertaining thereto, subject to the provisions of the said Act.

Applications must be lodged at the Land Agency Office as specified hereunder not later than the date specified, but may be lodged before such date, if so desired.

All applications lodged on or before such date will be treated as having been received on the closing day, and if there are more applicants than one for any block, the application to be granted will be determined by the Land Board. Should any lands remain unselected such will continue available until applied for or otherwise dealt with.

If a Land Board sitting becomes necessary, the applicants for the blocks will be duly notified of the date, time, and place of the meeting of the Board, and there shall be an interval of at least three days between the closing date and the sitting of the Board.

If an applicant wishes to appear before the Land Board in person he may apply to the Head Office or to the Clerk in Charge of any of the District or Branch Land Offices for a certificate to the Railway Department which, on presentation at the nearest Railway Station will entitle him to a Return Ticket, at Concession Rates, to the place where the Board will sit, available for seven days from the date of issue.

The selector of a Homestead Farm from any location must take the balance thereof, if any, under Conditional Purchase.

All marketable timber, including sandalwood and mallet, is reserved to the Crown, subject to the provisions of clause 18 of the regulations.
