INDUSTRIAL ARBITRATION ACT, 1912-1941.

IT is hereby notified, for general information, that His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor in Executive Council has been pleased, under the powers conferred by section 44 of the Industrial Arbitration Act, 1912-1941, to appoint Charles Henry Lamb, of Perth, as an acting member of the Court of Arbitration constituted under the said Act, vice Evan Thomas, a member of the said Court, to hold office as such acting member during the absence through illness of the said Evan Thomas, and to fix the rate of annual salary to be paid to the said Charles Henry Lamb as such acting member aforesaid at the same rate as that for the time being fixed in respect of the said Evan Thomas.
