Public Authorities (Postponement of Elections) Act, 1942.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Agric. 333/42.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of section 2 of the Public Authorities (Postponement of Elections) Act, 1942, "Public authority" includes, *inter alia*, any Board the members or some of the members of which Board the members or some of the members of which are required to be elected and which the Governor by Order in Council declares shall be a public authority for the purposes of the said Act: And whereas it is desirable that the Potato Growers' Advisory Committee (authorised under the Potato Growers' Licensing Act, 1941) should be declared a public authority: Now, there-fore, His Excellency the Lieutenaut-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, under the powers conferred by the Public Authorities (Postponement of Elections) Act, 1942, and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby declare that the Potato Growers' Advisory Committee shall be that the Potato Growers' Advisory Committee shall be a public authority for the purposes of the said Act.

LAND AND INCOME TAX ASSESSMENT ACT, 1907-1936.

Land Tax-Notice to make Returns.

NOTICE is hereby given that every person who was at noon on the 30th day of June, 1943, the owner, within the meaning of the said Act, of any land whatsoever in Western Australia and who is liable to land tax, is hereby required to make and furnish to me at the Office of the Commissioner of Taxation, Perth, on or before the 31st day of August, 1943, a land tax return in the prescribed form.
