HEALTH ACT, 1911-1942.

Merredin Road Board—Resolution.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 320 of the Health Act, 1911-1942 (as reprinted under the Amendments Incorporation Act, 1938), that a local authority may make by-laws, and may amend, repeal, or alter by-laws so made, and by section 321 of the said Act that the Governor may cause Model By-laws to be prepared and published in the *Gazette*, and that any local authority may adopt such by-laws with or without modification, as the by-laws of the said local authority; and whereas Model By-laws were prepared and gazetted as aforesaid on the 8th day of April, 1927, and the same were adopted by the Merredin Road Board; and whereas by a notice published in the *Government Gazette* on the 30th day of April, 1943, the said Model By-laws were amended by the insertion in Part I. thereof of new Model By-laws 1A and 7A as set forth in the said notice: Now, therefore, Merredin Road Board, being the health authority for the Health District of Merredin, doth hereby resolve and determine that the aforesaid new Model By-laws 1A and 7A, as now included in the Model By-laws heretofore adopted by the said Board, shall be adopted by and be and become part of the by-laws of the said health authority without modification.

HEALTH ACT, 1911-1942

Department of Public Health,
Perth, 23rd August, 1943.

HIS Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor in Council acting pursuant to sections 300 and 319 of the Health Act, 1911-1942, has been pleased to amend the regulations relating to Maternity Homes made under the said Act and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 8th day of November, 1918, and the 18th day of July, 1941, in the manner mentioned in the Schedule hereunder.

Schedule.

The above-mentioned regulations are amended as follows:—

1. New regulations are inserted after regulation 1, as follows:—

1A. (a) A license shall not be granted in respect of any building, structure, or apartment when the applicant for such license is over the age of 65 years or apparently over that age, unless such applicant proves to the satisfaction of the Commissioner that at all times during the currency of the license, the maternity home will be directly under the management and control of a person under the age of 65 years.

(b) Any proof of age requisite for the purposes of this regulation shall be in such form and of such nature as the Commissioner may require.

1B. A license shall not be granted in respect of any building, structure, or apartment for use as a maternity home, unless such building, structure, or apartment is distant not less than 15 feet on all sides thereof from the nearest boundary of the lot or parcel of land upon which the same is erected.

2. Regulation 2 is amended as follows:—(a) by deleting paragraph (d), and inserting in lieu thereof a paragraph as follows:—(d) Every room shall be accessible through a hall or passage which is used for no other purpose than that of a passage way. (b) By deleting from paragraph (f) the words "frequently washed" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "readily cleansed." (c) by deleting from paragraph (j) the word "Department" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "Commissioner."

3. A new regulation is inserted after regulation 2 as follows:—

2A. The licensee of a maternity home shall—(a) employ and maintain therein a nursing staff in the proportion of one midwifery nurse for every four patients accommodated in the maternity home at any one time; (b) employ a night nurse (who need not be a trained nurse) for duty at night when there are more than three patients in the maternity home at any one time.

4. Regulation 4 is amended by deleting the word "Secretary" in line 3 thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the word "Commissioner."

5. A new regulation is inserted after regulation 5 as follows:—

5A. (1) The licensee of a maternity home shall provide therein to the satisfaction of the Commissioner—(a) a labour ward properly equipped; and (b) a nursery.

(2) Only such labour ward, and no other room in the maternity home shall be used for the delivery of patients.

6. Regulation 6 is amended by adding at the end thereof, new paragraphs as follows:—(h) provide an autoclave or other approved device for pressure sterilisation; (i) provide any drugs ordinarily required by medical attendants, and such drugs as may be ordered by the Commissioner to be provided; (j) provide such appliances as are needed for carrying out any treatment ordered by medical attendants.

7. Regulation 8 is amended by deleting the word "Department" in line 5 thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the word "Commissioner."

8. Regulation 9 is amended by deleting the word "Secretary" in line 3 thereof, and inserting in lieu thereof the word "Commissioner."

9. Regulation 10 is amended by deleting the word "Department" in line 4 thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the word "Commissioner."

10. Regulation 12 is amended by deleting the word "Department" in line 3 thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the word "Commissioner."

THE PRISONS ACT, 1903-1918.

Schedule.

The abovementioned Prison Regulations, 1940, are amended as follows:—1. Regulation 152 is amended by adding at the end of paragraph (h) thereof a proviso as follows:—

Provided that this paragraph shall not apply to prisoners undergoing a sentence of imprisonment for life in whose case the marks system established by this regulation shall apply only to enable the Governor in Council to determine whether or not the Royal Prerogative of mercy shall be exercised in favour of such prisoners.

Alteration of Registry Districts.

NOTICE is hereby given that His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, acting in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages Act, 1894, has been pleased to:—(a) Abolish the Victoria Plains Registry District and amalgamate it with the Moora Registry District; (b) Cancel any previous description of the boundaries of the Moora Registry District, and to fix the boundaries of the said Moora Registry District, as from the 1st July, 1943, as follows:—

All that portion of land bounded by lines starting from a point on the seashore situate at the centre of the mouth of the Hill River, and extending generally east-north-easterly, upwards, along the centre of the said river, to a point situate in prolongation westerly of the northern boundary of Melbourne Location 938; thence easterly, to and along the said boundary to the north-eastern corner of the said location; thence north to a point situate west of the north-western corner of Location 926; thence easterly, to and along the northern boundary of the said Location 926, to the western boundary of Location 927; thence northerly and easterly, along boundaries of the said Location 927, to the north-eastern corner of same; thence east, to a point situate north of a point located 10 miles west of a survey point marked HK148, on Yorkkrakine Granite Rocks; thence south, to a point situate east of the summit of Mt. Matilda in the Wongan Hills; thence west, towards the said summit to a point situate north of the north-eastern corner of Avon Location 1956; thence westerly and west-south-westerly along boundaries of Locations 1956 and 1833, to the western corner of the latter location; thence continuing west-south-

westerly, to the north-eastern corner of Location 1957; thence westerly and southerly along boundaries of the said Location 1957, to the south-western side of Road No. 3051; thence generally north-westerly, along the said side, to the southern boundary of Melbourne Location 935; thence westerly, along the said boundary, to the eastern side of the Midland Railway Reserve; thence generally northerly, along the said side, to a point situate in prolongation easterly of the southern boundary of Location 937; thence westerly, to and along the said boundary; thence northerly, along the western boundary of the said location, to the right bank of the Moore River; thence generally westerly, downwards along the said bank, to a point situate in prolongation easterly of the southernmost boundary of Location 547; thence westerly and northerly, to and along the boundaries of the said location, to the north-western corner of same; thence westerly, to and along the northern boundary of Swan Location 1375, to the north-western corner of the said location; thence west to the seashore aforesaid; and thence generally north-north-westerly, along the said seashore, including the islands adjacent, to the starting point.
