### PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, } By His Excellency Sir James Mitchell,  
TO WIT. } K.C.M.G., Lieutenant-Governor in and  
JAMES MITCHELL, } over the State of Western Australia  
Lieutenant-Governor. and its Dependencies in the Common-  
[r.s.] wealth of Anstralia.

IN pursuance of the provisions of section 8 of the Fisheries Act, 1905-1940, I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Western Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby prohibit all persons from taking any fish whatsoever, by means of the method of fishing known as "foul-hooking" or "jagging," in any Western Australian waters lying to the south of the 25th parallel of south latitude, during the period between the 1st January and the 30th December in every year.
