WHEREAS it is enacted by section 116 of the Factories and Shops Act, 1920-37, that the expression "Public Holiday" shall mean certain days therein specified and any other day declared by Proclamation to be a public holiday for the purposes of the said Act: Now therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim and declare that Monday the 31st day of January, 1944, shall be a public holiday throughout the State for the purposes of the said Act, and shall be observed as a public holiday under every part of the said Act in which the expression occurs.

PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency Sir James Mitchell,
TO WIT. K.C.M.G., Lieutenant-Governor in and
over the State of Western Australia
Lieutenant-Governor.
[L.S.] and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia

No. 664/18.

WHEREAS under the provisions of section 4 of the Mining Tenements (War Time Exemption) Act, 1942, it is enacted that during a time of war the Governor

may by Proclamation, for the period mentioned in such Proclamation, waive or postpone the payment of rent on any mining tenement which is prescribed and payable under the Mining Act, 1904-1937, and exempt the holder of any mining tenement from his obligation under the Mining Act, 1904-1937, to observe, comply with or perform any conditions relating to such mining tenement; and whereas a time of war now exists to wit the War in which His Majesty is now engaged with Germany, Italy, and Japan (hereinafter referred to as "the present war") and it is desirable to give effect to the said section 4 in relation to certain mining tenements during the present War: Now, therefore I, Sir James Mitchell, Lieutenant-Governor as aforesaid, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, do by this Proclamation direct in relation to the mining tenements set out in the Schedule hereunder and for the period stated in the said Schedule that the payment of rent shall be waived and the holders of the mining tenements mentioned on the said Schedule shall be exempted from compliance with the labour covenants relating to such mining tenements.

IN THE COURT OF DISPUTED RETURNS.

In the matter of the Electoral Act, 1907-1940, and in the matter of the Election of a Member of the Legislative Assembly for the Avon District holden on the 20th day of November, 1943.

To the Court of Disputed Returns:

THE Petition of Ignatins George Boyle of Great Eastern highway, Merredin, in the State of Western Australia, Farmer, whose name is subscribed.

- 1. Your Petitioner was a candidate at the election of a Member of the legislative Assembly for the Avon District which was holden on the 20th day of November, 1943.
- 2. At the said election William Francis Telfer and your Petitioner were candidates.
- 3. On the counting of the votes for the said election the totals recorded in favour of the said William Francis Telfer were 1433 and of your Petitioner 1418.

4. Your Petitioner says:—(a) That persons not qualified to vote by virtue of the Electoral (War Time) Elections Act, 1943, voted by post and at polling places at the said election. (b) Members of the Forces voted contrary to the provisions of section 5 of the Electoral (War Time) Act, 1943. (c) That votes by post were taken by a person after his office as a Postal Vote Officer had been vacated. (d) That certain votes taken by post did not observe the directions of section 92 of the Electoral Act, 1907-1940. (e) That electors voted by post contrary to the provisions of section 90 of the Electoral Act, 1907-1940. (f) Certain polling places were closed at 7 o'clock in the afternoon instead of at 8 o'clock in the afternoon and many electors were deprived of their right to vote.

5. Your Petitioner claims that a majority of the valid votes cast at the election were east for him; alternatively that the majority of the electors have been prevented from electing the candidate they preferred.

Whereupon your Petitioner prays that it may be determined and declared:—(a) That the said William Francis Telfer was not duly elected, and (b) That your Petitioner was duly elected, or (c) That the said election was and is absolutely void.

For the purpose of this by-law ''Market'' shall mean any place where a number of producers of prescribed produce, products or provisions or their agents congregate for the purpose of selling or offering for sale any such prescribed produce, products or provisions. (2) Any person who shall commit a breach of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding fifty pounds.

48C. No person shall sell by wholesale in the metropolitan area, fruit and vegetables (except potatoes and onions), poultry and eggs by agents elsewhere than in the market established under the Act. For the purposes of this by-law "Agent'" means a person whose business, without along or control of or in generating with any either alone or as a part of or in connection with any other business, is to sell on behalf of producers or other persons any of the goods referred to herein on commission, whether such sale be by auction or otherwise. Nothing in this by-law shall prevent any person (not acting as agent for a producer) from selling or exposing for sale in his own shop or warehouse any prescribed produce, products or provisions.
