Bank Holiday throughout the State. PROCLAMATION

 WESTERN AUSTRALIA, TO WIT.
 By His Excellency Sir James Mitchell, K.C.M.G., Lieutenant-Governor in and over the State of Western Australia in the Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of the Bank Holidays Act, 1884, I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the said State, do by this my Proclamation appoint Wednesday, 9th May, 1945, a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout the State.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the said State, at Perth, this 8th day of May, 1945.
