WHEREAS by section 9 of the Fisheries Act, 1905-1940, it is provided that the Governor may by Proclamation prohibit (inter alia) the taking of any fish whatsoever, by any means of capture whatsoever, in any specified portion of Western Australian waters, during any specified that the interpretable water and waters are received year. fied time in any specified year, or during a specified por-tion of every year: Now, therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and in exercise of the aforesaid powers and of every other power enabling me in this behalf, do hereby prohibit all persons from taking any fish whatso-ever by any means of capture whatsoever in those portions of Western Australian waters specified in the Schedule hereto during the periods from May 1, 1945, to April 30, 1946, both dates inclusive.

Schedule.

The whole of the waters of that part of the Collie River between the weir opposite Recreation Reserve A7818 (Soldiers' Park) in the Collie Townsite and the Grain Distillery Weir west of Minningup Pool.

WHEREAS by sections 223 and 228 of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1906-1943 (6 Edwardi, No. 32), it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request of the Council, by notice in the Government Gazette, to declare any land reserved, used, or by purchase or exchange acquired for a street or way, or any place, bridge or thoroughfare, to be a public highway, and such land shall thereupon and thenceforth, from the date of such Proclamation, become and be absolutely dedicated to the public as a public highway within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force; and whereas the Geraldton Municipal Council has requested that certain land named and described in the Schedule hereunder has been used

for a street or way within the Municipality of Geraldton, be declared a public highway: Now, therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation declare the said land to be a public highway, and such land shall, from the date of this Proclamation, be absolutely dedicated to the public as a highway within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.

Vermin Act, 1918-1942. PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, | By His Excellency Sir James Mitchell, | K.C.M.G., Lieutenant-Governor in and over the State of Western Australia teutenant-Governor. [L.S.]

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 4 of the Vermin Act, 1918-1942, that "Vermin" means and includes any animal, bird or insect mentioned in the Third Schedule to the said Act and such other animals, birds or insects the names of which the Governor may by proclamation add to the said Schedule and that any proclamation whereby the names of other animals, birds or insects are added to the said Schedule may be restricted in its operation to any portion of the State to be defined by the proclamation; and whereas it is deemed desirable and expedient that the bird of the parrot or cockatoo species commonly known as "Galah"? shall be "Vermin"? for the purposes of the said Adalah" shall be "Vermin"? for the purposes of the said Act within the boundaries of the Victoria Plains Vermin district: Now, therefore I the said Lieutenant-Governor acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and in exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act do by this Proclama-tion add to the Third Schedule to the Vermin Act, 1918-1942, the name of the bird of the parrot or cockatoo species commonly known as "Galah," and declare that this Proclamation shall apply and have effect only in that portion of the State which is comprised within the boundaries of the Victoria Plains Vermin district as constituted under the said Act.
