PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency Sir James Mitchell, TO WIT. SK.C.M.G., Lieutenant-Governor in and JAMES MITCHELL, Lieutenant-Governor. [L.S.] wealth of Australia.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section 8 of the Totalisator Duty Act Amendment Act, 1946, that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation: Now, therefore I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim that the Totalisator Duty Act Amendment Act, 1946, shall come into operation on the 8th day of January, 1947.
