PROCLAMATION

WESTERN AUSTRALIA, By His Excellency Sir James Mitchell, K.C.M.G., Lieutenaut-Governor in and over the State of Western Australia to the Lieutenaut-Governor and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

P.W. 889/42.

WHEREAS by subsection (2) of section 7 of the Traffic Act Amendment Act, 1946 (No. 48), it is provided that subsection (1) of the said section of the said Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation; and whereas it is desirable to apply and bring into force and effect the said section of the said Act: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby proclaim and declare that subsection (1) of section 7 of the Traffic Act Amendment Act, 1946 (No. 48), shall come into operation on the 1st day of July, 1947.
