ELECTRICITY ACT, 1945.

State Electricity Commission,
of Western Australia,

Perth, 9th July, 1947.

HIS Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor in Executive Council, acting pursuant to the powers conferred by section 32 of the Electricity Act, 1945, and on the recommendation of the State Electricity Commission of Western Australia, has been pleased to amend the regulations made under and for the purposes of the said Act and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 27th day of June, 1947, in the manner provided for in the Schedule hereunder.

Schedule.

The abovementioned regulations are amended as follows:—

1. Regulation 3 is amended by inserting the following definitions in their appropriate places:—

“Australian Standard Specifications” means specifications issued by the Standards Association of Australia.

“British Standard Specifications” means specifications issued by the British Standards Institute.

“Recognised Approvals Authorities” means and includes:—The State Electricity Commission of Queensland; The Electrical Approvals Board of the State Electricity Commission of Victoria; The Electricity Authority of New South Wales which administers the materials approvals under Part 5 of the Electricity Development Act 1945; The Hydro Electric Commission of Tasmania.

2. A new part is added after Part 9, to stand as Part 10, as follows:—

Part 10.

Provisional Electrical Materials Approvals.

320. On and after the expiration of one week from the gazettal of this Part, it shall not be lawful for any person to sell, hire, expose or advertise for sale or hire any electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting, unless such electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting complies with the relevant British or Australian Standard Specification, or has been approved by the Commission, or has been approved by a recognised approvals authority in any other State of the Commonwealth of Australia.

321. It shall be necessary for any person in possession of such electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting to prove to the satisfaction of an Inspector of the Commission that the electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting complies with the British or Australian Standard Specification, or has been approved by a recognised approvals authority in another State, or has been approved by the Commission.

322. Where no British or Australian Standard Specification has been issued with respect to any electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting which any person desires to sell or hire, or where the said electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting has not been approved by a recognised approvals authority, then such person, unless he is in possession of a certificate in the prescribed form issued by the manufacturer or importer, shall apply to the Commission for the issue of an approval certificate with respect to the said electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting. Such application for a certificate shall be accompanied by such samples of the electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting as the Commission may require.

323. The Commission will examine the sample electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting and, if the said sample electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting is approved, issue a certificate in Form S.E.C. 38 in the Appendix hereto, to the applicant that articles identical with the sample electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting may be sold or hired.

324. The Commission may retain any or all of the samples submitted for examination and testing and no claim for compensation shall be lawful against the Commission for such retention.

325. Application for examination and testing of electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting shall be made to the Commission on the Form S.E.C. 37 in the Appendix hereto.

326. The applicant will pay to the Commission an examination and testing fee of £1 for each separate article submitted; such fee to be paid at the time application is made. No fee will be payable on any additional articles which the Commission may require for testing and/or examination where an identical article has already been so tested and/or examined.

327. Every manufacturer or importer of any electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting, shall supply to every person to whom such manufacturer or importer supplies any electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting for resale or hire, a certificate in accordance with Form No. S.E.C. 39 of the Appendix hereto, stating that such electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting manufactured or imported by him complies with the relevant British or Australian Standard Specification, or has been approved by any recognised approvals authority in any other State of the Commonwealth of Australia, or has been approved by the Commission.

328. Provided, however, that notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations, the Commission by notice in writing under the hand of the Secretary may require any person to submit to the Commission for testing and/or examination a sample of any electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting in his possession. If, after testing or examination, the Commission is of the opinion that such electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting is, or may become unsafe in use, the Commission may, by notice in writing to the said person prohibit the sale or use of the said electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting.

329. If in the opinion of an authorised Inspector of the Commission any electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting in use within the State is unsafe for use, the Commission may, by notice in writing under the hand of the Secretary, prohibit the use of the said electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting.

330. Any person who sells, hires or exposes for sale or for hire or advertises for sale or for hire any electrical apparatus, appliance or fitting must produce to the Commission's Inspector on demand a certificate of the manufacturer or importer or of the Commission as specified in regulations 323 and 327.

331. Certificate forms in the Form S.E.C. 39 in the Appendix hereto will be issued by the Commission to manufacturers and importers at a cost of six shillings per dozen.

332. Any person committing a breach of this Part, either by act or omission shall, on conviction, be liable to a penalty not exceeding fifty pounds.

3. The Appendix is amended by adding after Form S.E.C. 36, new forms, to stand as Forms S.E.C. 37, S.E.C. 38, and S.E.C. 39, as follows:—

HIS Excellency the Lieutenant Governor in Executive Council, acting pursuant to section 43 of the State Electricity Commission Act, 1945, has approved of the amendment, in the manner set forth in the Schedule hereto, of the by-laws made by the State Electricity Commission of Western Australia under the provisions of the said Act, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 9th day of August, 1946.

The abovementioned by-laws are amended by adding new by-laws as follows:—

Repeal.

3. By-laws Nos. 2 and 21 of the by-laws made under the provisions of the Government Electric Works Act, 1914, as amended, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 10th December, 1926, are repealed.

Industrial and Commercial Power Rate.

4. Electricity supplied to consumers for industrial and commercial power taken at low tension shall be charged at the following rates:—

(a) Where meters are read monthly as to all units consumed after the 30th June, 1947—For the first 40 units, 2d. per unit; for the next 4,960 units, 1¼d. per unit; for the next 20,000 units, 1d. per unit; for the next 25,000 units, 0.95d. per unit; over 50,000 units, 0.9d. per unit.

(b) Where meters are read quarterly as to all units consumed after the first meter reading made on or after the 1st July, 1947—For the first 120 units, 2d. per unit; for the next 14,880 units, 1¼d. per unit; for the next 60,000 units, 1d. per unit; for the next 75,000 units, 0.95d. per unit; over 150,000 units, 0.9d. per unit.

Meter Reading.

5. The reading of the meters or other measuring devices provided by the Commission shall be taken quarterly and shall be prima facie evidence of the quantity of electricity consumed. Provided that meters or other measuring devices which are used in connection with the supply of commercial and industrial power may be read monthly or quarterly at the discretion of the Commission.

If a meter or other measuring device fails to register, or is found to be inaccurate, the account for the period since the last account was rendered shall be adjusted, at the option of the Commission, upon the basis of—

(a) The account rendered to the consumer for the corresponding period of the previous year;

(b) the account for the last preceding period, a reasonable allowance being made for any known variations in the demand;

(c) an adjustment shall be made in accordance with the error shown on the Test Certificate of the meter;

(d) in the event of an account being rendered for a period of less than one quarter, a proportionate charge will be made.
