ROYAL COMMISSION

- I, the said Lieutenant-Governor, acting with the adrice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby appoint you, George William Simpson, William Stephen Henry Andrew and James Isaac Mann to be a Royal Commission to enquire into and report upon the following, namely:-
- Whether there can be initiated in Western Australia a social service which, with or without modifications, additions and safeguards, may embrace the following features:
 - (a) Compensation to all employees throughout the State during any period of incapacity for work, whatever the cause or circumstances of the incapacity, and notwithstanding an absence of insurance cover.
 - (b) An absence of any proposal forms, policies or documents of insurance, agents' commissions and expenses, and generally a substantial saving in overhead costs as compared with the total overhead costs now being incurred by insurance companies (and being passed on to industry in the form of premiums) in connection with workers' compensation insurance. (and
 - (c) The cost of the new social service to be borne by employers throughout the State, but such cost not to exceed the present cost to industry of premiums paid under workers' compensation legislation; nor the compensation to be less than that provided for under the said legislation; and the cost to be col-lected by a system of special stamps affixed to wages sheets, or by some other system, in lieu of the present system of payment of premiums.
 - (d) An assessment of risk in specified types of industry and a schedule of charges to employers varying with the type of risk and having relation to premium rates now being charged to employers in different types of industry.
 - (e) Legislation giving effect to the foregoing.

- What modifications, additions and safeguards would be necessary or expedient in view of Common-wealth social service legislation, or in order to place the social service on a sound basis.
- 3. The estimated annual cost for administration of the service and in meeting the claims of incapacitated employees, the estimate to be for each of the first five years after the initiation of the service.
- A suggested schedule of charges to specified different types of industry, and the estimated receipts therefrom, which should be sufficient to cover all estimated out-goings under the social service.
- 5. The form of statutory body (e.g. trustees) which should be charged with the administration of the social service, and the powers and duties of such statutory body.
- Whether, and in what circumstances, employees should make contribution (in respect of incapacity not arising out of or in the course of their employment) to the statutory fund established by the service, the rate of such contribution (if any) and times and method of payments, and whether such contributions (if any) should be voluntary or compulsory. (if any) should be voluntary or compulsory.
- The effect of any such service upon the business of insurance companies conducting workers' compensation insurance within the State, and whether such companies or any other bodies should or may properly underwrite the whole or any part of liabilities under the service.
- 8. Whether there is any similar social service or other scheme already in existence in any other part of the world, and, if so, the salient features and opera-tion thereof; but it is not desired that you should leave the State for the purpose of any enquiry in relation to this commission.
- If the State should guarantee the fulfilment of all liability under the social service, what contingent liability (if any) would the State reasonably face, and how best could such contingent liability be provided for.
- 10. Any other aspect in relation to the said social service which you should consider it desirable to examine and report upon.
- And I hereby appoint you the said George William Simpson to be Chairman of the said Royal Commission.

And I declare that you shall by virtue of this Commission be a Royal Commission within the Royal Commissioners' Powers Act, 1902, as reprinted in the Appendix to the Sessional Volume of the Statutes for the year 1928, and that you shall have the powers of a Royal Commission or the Chairman thereof under that Act.

And I hereby request you as soon as reasonably may be to report to me in writing the result of this your Commission.

Now therefore the Council of the City of Perth, being a local authority under the provisions of the abovementioned Act, doth hereby order that the by-laws made by it under the said Act and gazetted on the 24th day of December, 1925, as amended on the 26th day of April, 1946, be amended as follows:—

Paragraph (a) of clause 42 in Part I. of the said by laws is deleted and a new paragraph is inserted in lieu thereof as follows:—

(a) The occupier of any premises shall not keep any poultry or pigeons within that portion of the district embraced within the following boundaries:—On the North by Newcastle Street, on the East by Victoria Avenue and Lord Street, on the South by the Swan River, and on the West by Spring Street (and a prolongation of Spring Street to St. George's Place), St. George's Place, George Street (thence East along the railway line to Milligan

Street) Milligan Street, Shenton Street and Palmer-

POLICE ACT, 1892.

Police Department, Perth, 18th July, 1947.

THE Commissioner of Police, acting under the authority conferred by section 9 of the Police Act, 1892, and with the approval of the Minister for Police, has amended the regulations made under the said Act, as published in the Government Gazette on the 4th day of December, 1944, and amended by notices published in the Government Gazette on the 14th day of May, 1945, and the 21st day of March, 1947, in the manner set forth in the Schedule hereunder.

Schedule.

The abovementioned regulations are amended by deleting Regulation 131 and inserting in lieu thereof a new regulation, to stand as Regulation 131, as follows:—
131. Rules to be observed with regard to the searching of prisoners, and care of property held at all Police Stations, whether taken from a prisoner or otherwise:—

Searching of Prisoners.

- (1) The reserve sergeant or sergeant in charge for the time being, or senior reserve constable, will see that a male prisoner, before being placed in the cell, is thoroughly searched in his presence by the arresting constable, who will, at the time inform the prisoner of the amount of money and other property found on him, and then hand it to the reserve sergeant or senior reserve constable. The latter will then check the property and enter the same correctly described in the Charge Book and the Prisoners' Property Book, and place it in property envelopes, appropriately marked for identification. He will then sign the Prisoners' Property Book. The senior arresting constable, after checking entries of money and sundries, will sign the entry. When making entries in the Charge Book in regard to prisoners' property, full particulars need only be recorded in respect of property of a valuable nature (e.g., money, jewellery, pawn tickets, bank books, pension cards, etc.); articles of little value should be referred to as 'sundries.' In the Prisoners' Property Book full details of all items should be recorded, commencing with the entries as written in the Charge Book, and placed in the same sequence, a detailed list being recorded of all 'sundries.'
- (2) No constable will, unless it is unavoidable, search a prisoner without another member of the Force being present.

Violent Prisoner.

(3) If a prisoner is violent and objects to the arresting constable searching him, the reserve sergeant or senior reserve or other constable will conduct the search in the presence of the arresting constable. All such property is to remain in the custody of the Police until the prisoner has been either discharged, acquitted or sentenced.

Disposl of Prisoner's Property.

- (4) The property itself is to be sent to the place of trial (if prisoner is committed) previous to the day appointed for trial, so that it may be accessible either (if necessary) for the purpose of identification, or to be returned to the prisoner if discharged, or delivered to the sheriff or gaoler with a copy of the inventory if the prisoner be convicted.
- (a) Care is to be taken that property necessary for the purpose of identification remains as much as possible in the hands of the same member of the Force, so as to avoid rendering the evidence of identity complicated or embarrassing.
- (b) If the prisoner is discharged, the property is to be restored to him with the exception of any portions necessary to be retained as proofs in any future proceedings, or any portions proved to belong to another person, and which may be delivered to such person, on his indemnifying the member of the Force, sheriff or gaoler against any proceedings of the prisoner. It will be the duty of the member of the Force, sheriff or gaoler to inform the prisoner of the amount taken from him according to the duplicate inventory.
- (c) If the prisoner be convicted of an indictable offence and sentenced to imprisonment, the property found in his possession and seized by the Police is to be delivered to the sheriff or gaoler.
- (d) In cases of summary jurisdiction a similar course is to be pursued before and after conviction or discharge, as before and after trial.

- (e) When property is handed over to the sheriff or gaoler, one copy of the inventory should accompany it. On the other copy of the inventory the sheriff or gaoler's receipt for the property should be taken, and it should be retained by
- (f) When a prisoner's property is returned to him by the Police, his receipt for it should be taken on one copy of the inventory.
- (g) When a prisoner brought to the lock-up or police station in a state of intoxication is searched, the articles should always be taken from him by one person, and called out distinctly and entered in the inventory by another. No part of such property is to be returned to the prisoner until the decision of the Magistrate on the case is known, unless he is admitted to bail, when all property that the prisoner until the decision of the state of the prisoner until the decision of the state of the prisoner when the property is admitted to bail, when all property taken from him should be returned, except such portion as is required for evidence.
- (h) A prisoner may, by written order, assign to any person for his defence or other purpose any property taken from him which is not required for evidence, nor in any way connected with the charge against him, nor suspected to be unlawfully obtained.
- (i) Persons of known respectability arrested for some trifling misdemeanour need not be searched, but should be requested to produce such property as they may have on their persons, and should, if possible, be placed in a cell by them-
- (j) When prisoners are searched, the searching must be done so effectually that all instruments or articles of property which they ought not to retain may be taken from them.
- (k) Any prisoner may be searched at any time or place if it is suspected that he has upon his person any deadly weapon or any article which has been stolen or unlawfully obtained, or anything relating to the commission of any offence.
- (1) Persons suspected of making, uttering or having in their possession counterfeit coin should be searched immediately at the place where taken into custody, when the circumstances admit of it being done. If the search cannot then be made, precautions are to be taken to prevent the prisoner from getting rid of base coin or other evidence of guilt before being brought to the station.

Found or Stolen Property Books.

(5) The reserve sergeant or senior reserve constable will at once enter the description of any money or property brought to him, in the Found or Stolen Property Book, and mark it for identification.

Prisoners' Property under Escort.

(6) The reserve sergeant or lock-up keeper will, when a prisoner under escort to his destination is temporarily placed in a station or lock-up, enter in the Prisoners' Property Book particulars of any property belonging to such prisoner.

Correction of Entry.

(7) Should it become necessary to correct an entry made in the Prisoners' Property Book, or in any other public book or document, the original entry should not be erased, but should be ruled through and the correction neatly written in such a manner as to leave the original entry legible, and a brief explanatory note made in the margin.

Dangerous Weapons or Poisons.

(8) Unless obviously unnecessary, the prisoner's boots, socks, and all clothing should be removed and carefully examined to guard against the concealment of loaded arms, knives, razors or other dangerous weapons or poisons.

Dangerous Prisoners.

(9) Braces, belts, neckties, or bootlaces should be taken from dangerous prisoners or prisoners charged with serious offences, to prevent them doing themselves an injury. Pencils should be taken from prisoners to prevent them defacing walls, etc.

Spectacles.

(10) In the case of prisoners having spectacles, there is no need for the Police to take possession of such articles unless the prisoner is violent or drunk or there is reason to believe the prisoner may injure himself with the glasses, or there is some other good reason why the articles should be held by the Police. In cases where spectacles are taken possession of, they should be returned to the owners as soon as the necessity for the Police to hold the articles has passed.

Searching of Male Prisoners on Transfer.

(11) When male prisoners are being transferred from one station to another, or to a gaol, or for appearance at any Court, those who are charged with serious offences should be carefully searched immediately prior to their removal.

Prisoners charged with minor offences need not be searched when being so transferred, unless they have been incarcerated with others against whom serious charges have been laid, and it is suspected or believed that they may have letters or other property on their person for conveyance to friends or relatives of such other prisoners. The cells and exercise yards from which the prisoners are removed. should be carefully examined as the offenders are leaving in order to ascertain whether any object therein has been removed, damaged, or disturbed in any way. (Whenever any person charged is sentenced to imprisonment or remanded, or detained for any purpose, the officer charged with the safe keeping of such prisoner,

or where there is no such officer, the member of the Force in charge of the case at the Court, will be responsible for the safe delivery of the prisoner to the Reserve Sergeant, or Officer in Charge of the Station, and for giving accurate particulars of the result of the Court proceedings.)

Searching of Females.

(12) The services of a female, if necessary, are to be procured to search a female prisoner, and the Reserve Sergeant shall be in readiness to assist the former if required.

In the Perth or Fremantle districts, the Police Matron, or a woman constable should be used.

Female to be taken to Headquarters.

(13) In the Perth or Fremantle districts any female taken to a suburban Station should be removed in the Police patrol car to the headquarters Station as soon as practicable.

Female Drug Addicts-Searching of.

- (14) All prostitutes and female offenders who are suspected drug addicts, when arrested are to be dealt with on the lines indicated in paragraphs 11 and 12 of these Rules. Such offenders should be carefully searched by a matron or female searcher immediately after being charged, in order to ascertain whether they are in possession of cocaine or other dangerous drugs.
- (15) The Reserve Sergeant or Sergeant in charge of the Station for the time being, will at all times be personally responsible for all money, valuables and other property held at the Station, or received at the Station during his tour of duty, whether such property is taken from a prisoner or otherwise.
- (16) He will see that a complete record of such property is correctly entered in the books supplied for that purpose and that cash, jewellery and other valuable property is locked in the safe, strong box or strong room. On being relieved, he will hand over to the relieving officer and obtain the necessary acknowledgment.
- (17) When the property of a prisoner or any part of it is impounded by any member of the C.I.B. an entry to that effect is to be made in red ink in the appropriate books and such property secured as aforementioned.
- (18) If the officer concerned requires the property of any prisoner or part thereof, for any purpose, the necessary entry should be made and the same signed by the officer taking the property and initialled by the officer handing over.
- (19) These Rules or such portion of them as are applicable shall apply to all Stations throughout the State.
