Boot and Shoe Repairs.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 205.

Revocation.

2. Prices Control Order No. 167 is hereby revoked.

Maximum Rates.

3. I fix and declare the maximum rate at which the kinds of service of boot or shoe repairing set out in the Schedule to this Order, including all the materials therefor, may be supplied by any person by retail to be the rate set out in that Schedule opposite each such kind of boot or shoe repairing.

Exhibition of Price List.

4. Every person who supplies or offers to supply any kind of service of boot or shoe repairing, a maximum rate for the supply of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business, or if he has more than one place of business, in each of his places of business, a notice setting forth the maximum rate fixed by the provisions of this Order for the supply by him of that kind of service of boot or shoe repairing. I hereby declare that any form of notice shall be deemed to be an approved form if it is otherwise in compliance with regulation 49 of the Regulations.

Variation of Maximum Rates by Notice.

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum rate at which any kind of service of boot and shoe repairing specified in a

notice in pursuance of this paragraph, may be supplied by any person to whom such notice is given, to be such rate as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

## PRICES CONTROL ACT, 1948.

Prices Control Order No. 206.

Ales, Lagers and Stouts—Kalgoorlie Areas.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Control Regulations, 1949, I, Constantin Paul Mathea, Prices Control Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

## Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Control Order No. 206.

## Revocation.

2. Commonwealth Prices Regulation Order No. 2063 published in the *Commonwealth Gazette* on the 23rd April, 1945, as amended by the Commonwealth Prices Regulation Orders published in the *Commonwealth Gazette* on the date referred to hereunder in each case, is hereby revoked.

No. 2109, the 5th day of June, 1945;

No. 2239, the 10th day of September, 1945.

No. 2351, the 10th day of December, 1945.

## Definitions.

3. In this Order and the Schedule thereto, unless the contrary intention appears—

- (a) "Kalgoorlie areas" means all those areas of Western Australia comprised within a radius of three miles from the principal post office at each of the following towns:—Kalgoorlie, Coolgardie, Boulder, Ora Banda, Broad Arrow and Kanowna.
- (b) "oz." means a fluid ounce or ounces as the case may be;
- (c) (1) "small 5 oz. glass" means any glass or similar container containing less than 5 oz.;
- (2) "5 oz. glass" means any glass or similar container containing 5 oz. or more but less than 6 oz.;
- (3) "6 oz. glass" means any glass or similar container containing 6 oz. or more but less than 8 oz.;
- (4) "8 oz. glass" means any glass or similar container containing 8 oz. or more but less than 10 oz.;
- (5) "10 oz. glass or pot" means any glass or similar container containing 10 oz. or more but less than 11 oz.;
- (6) "11 oz. glass or pot" means any glass or similar container containing not less than 11 oz.;
- (7) "bottle" means a reputed quart (26 fluid oz.);
- (8) "half-bottle" means a reputed pint (13 fluid oz.);
- (9) "nip" means a bottle containing not less than 6  $\frac{2}{3}$  fluid oz.;
- (10) "demi-nip" means a bottle containing not less than 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  fluid oz.

## Maximum Prices—Quantities Specified in Schedule.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any quantity of ale, lager or stout specified in the Schedule to this Order may be sold by retail in the Kalgoorlie areas, to be the price specified in that Schedule.

## Quantities not Specified.

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any ale, lager or stout specified in the Schedule to this Order may be sold in quantities other than those specified in that Schedule, to be the maximum price fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order for the next smaller quantity of such ale, lager or stout specified in that Schedule, or if there is no smaller quantity specified then such price (calculated to the nearest downward halfpenny) as bears the same ratio to the maximum price fixed for the next higher measure or quantity as the quantity actually sold bears to the next higher quantity.

## Sales in Dining-room or Lounge.

6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum prices at which any quantity of ale, lager or stout specified in the Schedule to this Order may be sold by any person in any hotel dining-room or lounge in the Kalgoorlie areas, to be the prices specified in the said Schedule plus an amount equal to the difference between the hotel dining-room or lounge prices respectively charged by that person on 17th September, 1948, for any such ale, lager or stout, and the public bar prices charged by that person for such ale, lager or stout on such date: Provided that if in the case of any sale, by reason of the absence of records such difference between the hotel dining-room or lounge prices and the public bar prices at 17th September, 1948, cannot be ascertained, the provisions of this paragraph shall not apply and such sale shall be deemed to have been made in the public bar.

## Exhibition of Maximum Prices.

7. Every person who sells or has for sale by retail in the Kalgoorlie areas, any ale, lager or stout the maximum price for the sale of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business or if he has more than one place of business in each of his places of business and in each of his bars, lounges, dining-rooms or other places at such place

or places of business where ale, lager or stout are sold or had for sale, particulars of the maximum prices fixed by or under the provisions of this Order for the sale by him of such ale, lager or stout.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

8. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which ale, lager or stout specified in a notice given in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold in the Kalgoorlie areas, by any person to whom such notice is given, to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to such person.
